

Annual Report 2019-2020



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Through the Office for Dispute Resolution, the Pennsylvania Department of Education (PDE) fulfills its statutory mandate to maintain a special education due process system. PDE contracts with the Central Susquehanna Intermediate Unit (CSIU) to provide fiscal and certain management support for that office, without becoming involved in substantive operations. The hearing officers and mediators are free from interference or influence on any matters affecting the outcome of individual mediations and due process hearings. This includes, without limitation, interference or influence from any entity, individual, or group, such as parents, advocacy groups, school districts, intermediate units including CSIU, ODR staff and PDE. At the same time, those hearing officers and mediators are provided with administrative support, as well as training delivered in a manner preserving their impartiality through ODR, which itself is also free of such interference or influence.

The Central Susquehanna Intermediate Unit will not discriminate in educational programs, activities or employment practices based on race, color, national origin, gender, disability, marital status, age, religion, sexual orientation, ancestry, union membership or other legally protected classifications. Announcement of this policy is in accord with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972, Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, and the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990. 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Introduction

The Office for Dispute Resolution (ODR) provides the resources for parents and local educational agencies (LEAs) to resolve educational disputes involving children served by the early intervention system, students with disabilities (or thought to have disabilities) and students who are gifted (or thought to be gifted). Pennsylvania's recognition as an "exemplar state" by the Office for Special Education Programs (OSEP) and the Center for Appropriate Dispute Resolution in Special Education (CADRE) is an acknowledgement of the experience, education, and training of ODR staff and the quality of ODR services provided.¹ ODR's listserv is available at http://odr-pa.org/subscribe-to-odr/.

Due to the COVID-19 crisis, ODR began providing all its services virtually as of March 16, 2020, although virtual due process hearings have been available for the past five years. Following an extensive pilot program, ODR hearing officers had already offered virtual hearings since 2015. When the pandemic necessitated that all services become virtual, ODR's experience with virtual hearings allowed due process in the Commonwealth to remain on track. Given this experience, Pennsylvania hearing officers were asked to present both statewide to Pennsylvania stakeholders and nationally to states with significantly less (or no) experience with virtual hearings. In May 2020, two hearing officers presented a national webinar through the Center for Appropriate Dispute Resolution in Special Education (CADRE), affiliated with the University of Oregon, to state education agency officials, special education consultants, and other due process professionals. That presentation was followed by others to include a PaTTAN-sponsored virtual summit to Pennsylvania special education administrators and a national webinar through the Technical Assistance for Excellence in Special Education (TAESE) program at the

Center for Persons with Disabilities, affiliated with Utah State University, to state education agency officials, as well as a featured LRP Publications article.

In addition, ODR- contracted mediators and facilitators offered virtual mediation and virtual IEP Facilitation to ensure no lapse in ODR's provisions of services. Nonetheless, ODR discerned a slowdown in requests for all services as of March, as its stakeholders grappled with the reality of a state-wide shutdown.

ODR Stakeholder Council

The ODR Stakeholder Council (SC) brings together representatives from a broad array of stakeholders to provide functional input and recommendations on the special education dispute resolution system. <u>Detailed biographical information</u> <u>on each SC member</u> is available on the ODR website (https://odr-pa.org/stakeholder-council-bios/).

Outreach

ODR employees and hearing officers speak at conferences throughout the year as part of stakeholder education, including: Pennsylvania Association of Intermediate Units; Special Education Leadership Academy; National Academy for IDEA Administrative Law Judges and Impartial Hearing Officers; Pennsylvania Council for Exceptional Children (PACEC) Conference; Pennsylvania Bar Institute's Exceptional Children Conference (ECC); the Arc Alliance; PEAL Center; HUNE; Special Education Advisory Panel (SEAP); School District of Philadelphia; and various Intermediate Units and Local Task Forces. The ODR Program Manager is the lead trainer for *Creating Agreement,* a conflict resolution training program.

ODR staff and the hearing officers collaborate to produce videos, webinars, and podcasts on topics germane to both parents and educators. Development of training products for parents and educators is an ongoing process and based upon stakeholder needs. During FY 2019-2020, ODR produced several videos providing an overview of ODR services, the Special Education ConsultLine, and a video entitled Why Mediation which features one of ODR's mediators.

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Hearing Officer Training

The hearing officers engage in rigorous professional development each year, both in-house and through highly regarded professional associations. They are members of the National Association of Hearing Officials (NAHO) and participate in the certification process. Hearing officers regularly attend the NAHO conference and/or the National Academy for IDEA Administrative Law Judges and Impartial Hearing Officers or other national conferences. In addition, they participate in numerous trainings conducted within the Commonwealth where they are frequently asked to also participate as session presenters. The hearing officers routinely attend Pennsylvania Department of Education (PDE) and Pennsylvania Training and Technical Assistance Network (PaTTAN) sponsored conferences and presentations, as well as those of other organizations, related to a myriad of issues impacting children with disabilities. After the onset of the pandemic, hearing officers frequently attended virtual trainings and webinars directly related to continuing education during COVID-19.

ODR Projects

Hearing Officer Settlement Conferences

Since March 2017, Hearing Officer Settlement Conferences (HOSCs) have been a regularly-offered service in any dispute where a complaint has been filed, and both parties agree to a HOSC. ODR maintains a randomized list of HOSC hearing officer assignments. When parties request a HOSC, the next hearing officer on the list is assigned (after confirming that the hearing officer does not have an ongoing case with the family or the LEA—if so, the next hearing officer on the list would receive the assignment). Each hearing officer has a slightly different approach to the details of a HOSC, but the same general framework applies—a three-sided conversation between the settlement hearing officer and the attorneys (or LEA attorney and pro se parent) takes place. Thereafter, the settlement hearing officer typically has a one-sided conversation with each party. At that point, each HOSC moves in its own unique direction—sometimes resolution has been achieved, sometimes further three-sided conversations are held, sometimes further one-sided conversations are held. The HOSC can continue until the parties feel it has met its goals, or their unfacilitated resolution conversations can continue without the settlement hearing officer. For this reporting period, there were 21 completed HOSC processes, resulting in an 81% settlement rate. This is in line with the overall 83% settlement rate since the inception of the program. Hearings Via Video Conference

Starting in 2015, ODR piloted hearings via video conference, sometimes referred to as remote hearings or virtual hearings. Using an internet-based, highly secure videoconference platform, easily accessed through any webcam-enabled computer, laptop, or tablet, hearings via video conference increased efficiencies and access in special education due process even before the COVID-19 school closures.

During the COVID-19 school closures, video conferencing enabled hearings to proceed, ensuring compliance with IDEA statutory hearing requirements, none of which were set aside by the federal Department of Education. Hearing Officers quickly adopted flexible policies that could be adjusted on a case-by-case basis depending on the needs of the parties, witnesses, and attorneys. This was a new experience for the majority of the bar and some hearing officers as well. Initially, hearings via video conference proceeded at a slower pace as Hearing Officers and attorneys became more comfortable with the technology. Currently, most hearings via video conference proceed at the same pace as in person hearings.

Electronic Exhibits Pilot

For nearly five years, ODR has piloted a program for electronic submission of evidence at due process hearings. Before the COVID-19 school closures, Hearing Officers individually decided whether to permit parties to file exhibits electronically on a case-by-case basis. After the COVID-19 school closures, filing exhibits electronically has become part and parcel to hearings via video conference. Digital exhibits eliminate the need to ship cumbersome exhibit binders from witness to witness when witnesses are not in the same physical space, eliminating both a significant cost and a potential vector for COVID-19 transmission. Hearing Officers

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have also adopted a flexible protocol for using digital exhibits during hearing sessions on a case-by-case basis. In most cases, Hearing Officers display the exhibits to all participants, including the witnesses, so that witnesses do not have to manage or secure the evidence files. In some cases, Hearing Officers provide witnesses temporary, direct access to the files and then ensure the files are not retained. **ConsultLine**

The Special Education ConsultLine is a toll-free information helpline for parents and advocates who have questions or concerns about special education for school-age children. ConsultLine is staffed by four Specialists who provide information about special education, gifted education, and Section 504 of the *Rehabilitation Act of 1973*. Specialists assess the nature of the caller's inquiry or concern and provide information and assistance. Examples of the service provided include:

- Information about the processes involved in having a child evaluated, identified, and provided with special education, accommodations, and related services;
- Parent's rights and procedural safeguards, including information about regulations;
- Information, assistance and access to the state complaint process managed by the Pennsylvania Department of Education's Bureau of Special Education (BSE);
- Dispute resolution services and options for resolving disagreements about a child's special education program; and
- Resources, publications, websites and referrals to disability-related organizations.

Specialists respond to requests for information by calling the individual directly. In an attempt to speak with everyone who has requested information, Specialists call individuals at least three times over the course of three business days. This has been an effective protocol for providing service in an equitable and timely manner.

ConsultLine Specialists work very diligently behind the scenes to ensure that all constituents have access to the most updated and accurate information and resources:

- Ensuring that Hearing Officer decisions have all personally identifiable information removed and that the decisions meet accessibility standards prior to posting on ODR's website
- Maintaining the Parent Resource Library section of ODR's website
- Conducting group presentations for interested stakeholders via in-person or virtual sessions on the function, purpose, and services of ODR
- Collaborating with PaTTAN to ensure the OSEP Policy Letter database remains up to date
- Collaborating with the Center for Schools and Communities on Family Engagement activities

Call Activity

During FY 2019-2020, ConsultLine Specialists served 1,988 constituents, including 29 callers who spoke Spanish via a third-party interpretation service. Specialists receive calls via the ConsultLine voicemail, email, and online contact form. ConsultLine Specialists also receive parent engagement referrals from ODR case managers. These referrals give parents who are preparing for a facilitation or mediation or are representing themselves in a due process hearing an opportunity to speak with a ConsultLine/Parent Engagement Specialist who can answer questions prior to the facilitation, mediation, or hearing.

As a result of the COVID-19 crisis, and the ensuing shut down of schools, ConsultLine saw an immediate impact on the volume of calls. Prior to the pandemic, the number of constituents served was almost equal (one less) to that of the prior fiscal year. Once the school closure occurred on March 16, calls and online requests for assistance slowed down drastically, resulting in this decrease. As of the issuance of this Annual Report, ConsultLine calls are increasing, as schools approach the new school year—whether in person or virtually—and ODR anticipates a resumption of its usual number of calls once school begins.


Caller Demographics

Demographic information was volunteered during 897 calls during FY 2019-2020. The following statistics provide a general impression of call activity across the state.

ConsultLine received the highest volume of calls from the following regions:

Figure 1: FY 2019-2020 Call Activity by Intermediate Unit





Types of Inquiries

ConsultLine Specialists document the main topics associated with a caller's question(s). During FY 2019-2020, the most regularly recurring topics, in order of frequency, pertained to the following:

- Multidisciplinary evaluation
- Mediation
- Educational placement
- IEP content
- IEP implementation

Other high interest topics included due process hearings; discipline; advocates; notice; and transportation. Specialists provided publications, forms, web resources and other materials related to the caller's interests in 1,168 instances; the majority of this information was delivered electronically.





Call Resolution Process and Provision of BSE Complaint Packets

ConsultLine's Call Resolution Process (CRP) is an effective dispute resolution tool for compliance-related concerns for IDEA-related issues and certain types of concerns related to Section 504 of the *Rehabilitation Act of 1973*. During CRP, the Specialist acts as a conduit of information between the parent (as defined in 34 CFR § 300.30) and the school; the Specialist does not serve as an advocate, decisionmaker, mediator, or compliance advisor.

The CRP format and process includes an email summarizing the parent's compliance-related concerns, and to the extent known, the parent's proposed resolution. The email is prepared by the Specialist in consultation with the parent so that the message accurately reflects the nature of the issue. Once the message is drafted and reviewed with the parent, the parent provides verbal permission to send the message to the following recipients: LEA administrator responsible for special education; BSE division chief; and the regional BSE advisor. Once the email has been sent, the Specialist's involvement in CRP has concluded.

During FY 2019-2020, CRP was offered to 121 callers, and provided with the parent's permission in 60 instances. Common reasons for declining the CRP were the parent wanted to speak/meet with the school one more time to try to resolve the issue before sending the CRP or the parent wanted to speak with the other parent/advocate before agreeing to send the CRP. The top three most frequent issues in a CRP were IEP implementation (29), child out of school (9), and multidisciplinary evaluation (4).

Information about the BSE complaint process and the state complaint form is sent to the parent when CRP has been offered, but also when requested by the caller. During FY 2019-2020, 131 state complaint forms and information packets were distributed to callers.

Gifted Education

ConsultLine Specialists assist callers who have questions or concerns about Chapter 16/gifted education. Some of these callers allege compliance violations. When this occurs, the Specialist provides the caller with information about the procedural safeguards for gifted education including the option to file a written complaint. During FY 2019-2020, ConsultLine Specialists responded to 54 callers whose questions or concerns were specifically related to gifted education.

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



Figure 3: Gifted Education ConsultLine Calls – Five-Year Retrospective

ConsultLine Feedback

When callers provide contact information, Specialists conclude service by mailing or emailing an evaluation survey to the caller. The survey is brief, and it can be completed and returned anonymously. Survey participants are asked to provide comments and to answer several satisfaction-based questions. Survey respondents assess the following areas: usefulness of information; identifying options for resolving concerns; timeliness of service; and general satisfaction. For FY 2019-2020, survey results show that ConsultLine continues to maintain an extremely high level of satisfaction amongst constituents.





The following sample of comments were made via the survey during FY 2019-2020.

ConsultLine Feedback

"This is the very best service you can provide a special needs parent. The consultant was very knowledgable [sic], gave me guidance and help with my issue and documentation/law that I can read further. This is exactly what i[sic] needed and wanted. The consultant was very understanding of parents' perspective and it was a blessing to have this resource so I can be an informed parent and an advocate for my child."

"She was knowledgeable, understanding and professional. Reading the information on my own is something different than people explaining it to me. I had better understanding of mediation after the phone call. Will highly recommend the service to other parents."

"The people that answer the phones are amazing. They are always helpful and knowledgeable about concerns I have had."

Professional Development

ConsultLine staff continue to participate in high quality professional development opportunities to remain well informed and effective in conveying useful information and relevant resources to callers. During FY 2019-2020, professional development activities included the LRP National Institute; Pennsylvania Bar Institute's Exceptional Children Conference; and Lehigh University's Special Education Law Symposium. ConsultLine staff have also participated in many webinars and training related to special education during the COVID pandemic. Additionally, specialists are involved in outreach activities and collaboration with cross-agency staff on various ODR, BSE, and CADRE initiatives.



Resolution Meeting Facilitation

During FY 2019-2020, ODR received seven requests for a facilitator to attend a resolution meeting. In one instance, a party declined to have a facilitator attend. Of the six agreed upon facilitated resolution meetings, an agreement was reached in four of the six meetings.


IEP/GIEP/Section 504 Facilitation Requests


In 2019-2020, there were 79 requests for IEP Facilitation with two requests carried over from 2018-2019. Consistent with prior years, the overwhelming majority of the requests—70—pertained to school aged students and their IEPs. There were no requests for children ages birth to three years old. The nine remaining requests came from parents of children ages 3-5 (two requests); one (1) request under Section 504; and six (6) requests for gifted education facilitation.

IEP Facilitation is a voluntary service, and both the parent and school must agree to invite a facilitator into the IEP meeting. For requests pertaining to school aged students, in four instances the parent declined to participate in IEP Facilitation, and in four instances the school declined to participate. For gifted students, the parent declined to participate one time and the school declined to participate one time. In fourteen (14) occurrences, the request for facilitation was withdrawn, leaving 49 sessions with a facilitator.

IEP Facilitation Outcomes-IDEA

Of the 49 Facilitations which took place, the two IEP team meetings regarding a child age 3-5 were successful in writing an IEP with the assistance of a facilitator. As to school aged facilitations, in 22 instances an IEP was written; in 14 team meetings a partial IEP was written. In 11 cases the IEP was not agreed upon even with the assistance and support of a facilitator. One request under Section 504/Chapter 15 resulted in an agreed upon plan. At the time of this report, one request for IEP Facilitation remains active.





GIEP-Outcomes

There were six requests for GIEP Facilitation, with three requests moving forward, resulting in two full or partial GIEPs being written. In one instance, the GIEP was not agreed upon despite the presence of a facilitator.

IEP Facilitation Feedback

IEP Facilitation Feedback

"I felt the facilitator kept the meeting on track and made sure both sides were heard."

Mediation Requests

ODR received 367 requests for mediation during FY 2019-2020. This is approximately the same number of requests received during 2018-2019 (374), despite the slowdown in requests attributable to the COVID-19 crisis. In addition, 52 mediations carried over from FY 2018-2019, for a total of 419 mediations being reported here.

The breakdown of mediation outcomes is as follows:




There were 54 requests for mediation in FY 2019-2020 and five requests that carried over from FY 2018-2019, for a total of 59 requests. 35 of these requests resulted in a mediation being held; 30 of which resulted in an agreement. In the remaining five instances, parties were unable to reach an agreement. In nine instances, the mediation was declined by one of the parties. In one instance, the parent did not respond to the request for mediation. In nine instances, the request for mediation. In nine instances, the request for mediation.






<u>School Age</u>

There were 288 requests for mediation in FY 2019-2020 and 46 requests that carried over from FY 2018-2019, for a total of 334 requests. Of the 157 mediations held, parties reached agreement in 109 instances. In 48 instances, there was no agreement reached. In 58 instances, mediation was declined. In 15 instances, the parents did not respond to the request for mediation. In three instances, the parent declined to participate in a virtual mediation during the COVID-19 shutdown. In 83 instances, the request for mediation was withdrawn. 18 remained active at the time of this report.





Section 504/Chapter 15

There were four requests for mediation under Section 504/Chapter 15, with two mediations held, but no agreement on the service plan reached. Mediation was declined in one instance and withdrawn in the other.






Figure 8: Section 504/Chapter 15 Mediation Outcomes

Gifted Education

There were 20 requests for mediation pertaining to gifted education in FY 2019-2020 and one request that carried over from FY 2018-2019, for a total of 21 requests. Of the 10 mediations held, eight resulted in an agreement. In two instances, the parties were unable to reach agreement. In five instances, mediation was declined. In six instances, the request for mediation was withdrawn.







Summary of Mediations Declined


Of the 71 mediations declined, parents declined in four instances, and schools declined to participate in mediation in 67 instances.





She asked relevant and engaging questions that allowed both parties to engage with one another to come to a resolution."



Due Process Requests

ODR has observed an upward trend in due process requests in the past several years and was working with a researcher to attempt to identify, from a statistical perspective, reasons why this was occurring. The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania was on track to exceed the number of due process requests from FY 2018-2019 (1,000), when the COVID-19 shutdown occurred. During FY 2019-2020, ODR received 998 requests for due process, with schools closed for approximately 3 months of the reporting period because of the coronavirus pandemic. It is suspected that this number would have greatly exceeded the previous year had the shutdown not occurred, and, it is believed, temporarily suspended parties from making requests for ODR services. Because the COVID-19 shutdown is a significant intervening event, ODR has adjusted its work with the researcher as it moves forward with the upcoming school year in what, by any measure, will be unprecedented.




Figure 13: Due Process Requests: 2010-2011 to 2019-2020

The overwhelming number of due process requests come from an attorney representing the parent. In a minority of cases, parents requested ODR services on their own, without being represented by counsel. Five-Year Retrospective of Due Process by Age Group





Figure 14: Due Process Requests – Birth-3

Figure 15: Due Process Requests – 3-5








Figure 16: Due Process Requests – School Age








Figure 18: Due Process Requests – Gifted Education




Figure 19: Pennsylvania Map of Due Process Requests by Intermediate Unit

Appeals to State and Federal Court

During FY 2019-2020, there were 28 appeals to state or federal court; only six of these appeals pertained to 2019-2020 requests for hearing, with the balance pre-dating the reporting period. The appellant chose federal court in 100% of the appeals. Parents accounted for 71% of the total number of appeals received. As of the close of the reporting period, 22 cases were still in progress, four cases settled, and one case was voluntarily dismissed.

A judge ruled on the substantive aspect of the case in one instance, affirming the hearing officer's decision in whole.
