Annual Report 2020-2021



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Through the Office for Dispute Resolution, the Pennsylvania Department of Education (PDE) fulfills its statutory mandate to maintain a special education due process system. PDE contracts with the Central Susquehanna Intermediate Unit (CSIU) to provide fiscal and certain management support for that office, without becoming involved in substantive operations. The hearing officers and mediators are free from interference or influence on any matters affecting the outcome of individual mediations and due process hearings. This includes, without limitation, interference or influence from any entity, individual, or group, such as parents, advocacy groups, school districts, intermediate units including CSIU, ODR staff and PDE. At the same time, those hearing officers and mediators are provided with administrative support, as well as training delivered in a manner preserving their impartiality through ODR, which itself is also free of such interference or influence.

The Central Susquehanna Intermediate Unit will not discriminate in educational programs, activities or employment practices based on race, color, national origin, gender, disability, marital status, age, religion, sexual orientation, ancestry, union membership or other legally protected classifications. Announcement of this policy is in accord with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972, Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, and the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990. 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
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# **Introduction**

The Office for Dispute Resolution (ODR) provides the resources for parents<sup>1</sup> and local educational agencies (LEAs) to resolve educational disputes involving children served by the early intervention system, students with disabilities (or thought to have disabilities) and students who are gifted (or thought to be gifted). Pennsylvania’s recognition as an “exemplar state” by the Office for Special Education Programs (OSEP) and the Center for Appropriate Dispute Resolution in Special Education (CADRE) is an acknowledgement of the experience, education, and training of ODR staff<sup>2</sup> and the quality of ODR services provided.<sup>3</sup> In addition to its website, publications, and videos, ODR remains in contact with its stakeholders through a listserv. ODR’s listserv is available at <http://odr-pa.org/subscribe-to-odr/>.

Due to the COVID-19 crisis, ODR began providing all of its services virtually as of March 16, 2020, and throughout the 2020-21 fiscal year (FY). In-person services were provided upon request in just four mediations, and one due process hearing. Because ODR has been offering virtual due process hearings since 2015, there was a seamless transition to virtual hearings. Video conferencing allowed hearings to proceed, ensuring compliance with IDEA statutory hearing requirements, none of which were set aside by the US Department of Education. Hearing Officers quickly adopted flexible policies that could be adjusted on a case-by-case basis depending on the needs of the parties, witnesses, and attorneys. This

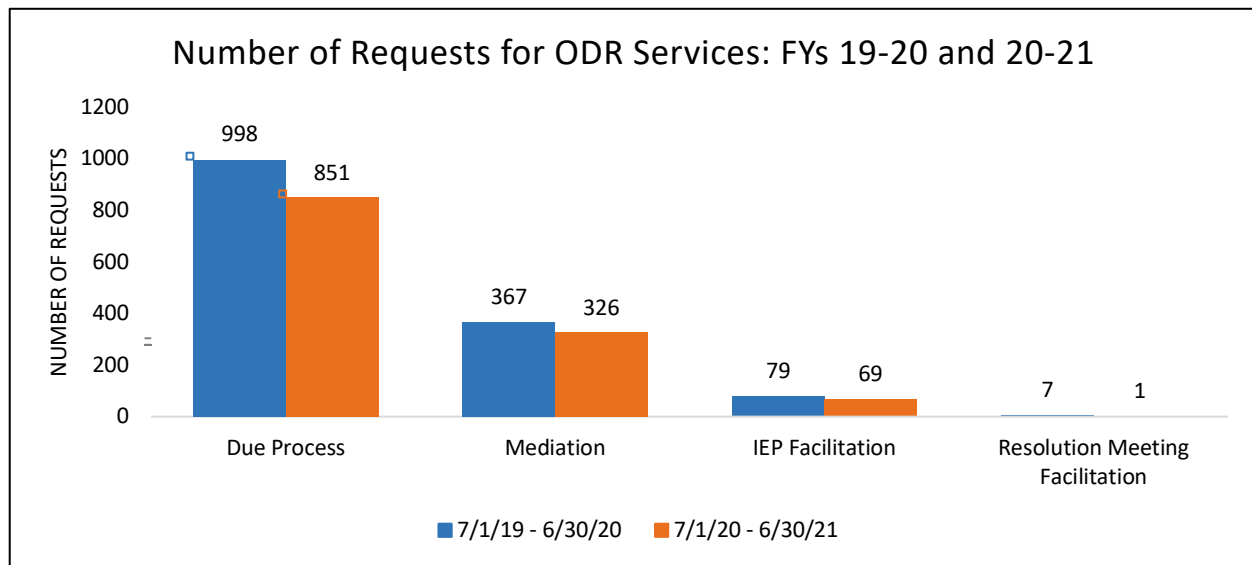
was a new experience for the majority of attorneys and some hearing officers as well. Initially, hearings via video conference proceeded at a slower pace until participants became more comfortable with the technology. Currently, most virtual hearings proceed at the same pace as in-person hearings.

In addition, the due process system was well-positioned to handle electronic exhibits at hearing. For nearly five years preceding the pandemic, ODR had piloted a program for electronic submission of evidence at due process hearings. After the COVID-19 school closures, and throughout this fiscal year, filing exhibits electronically became part and parcel to hearings via video conference. Digital exhibits eliminated the need to ship cumbersome exhibit binders from witness to witness when witnesses were not in the same physical space, eliminating both a significant cost and a potential vector for COVID-19 transmission.

Virtual IEP facilitations and mediations were not a regularly offered service of ODR prior to the pandemic, but ODR-contracted mediators and facilitators quickly learned how to operate on a virtual platform to continue to offer their services seamlessly. During the upcoming fiscal year, parties will have the use of an electronic signature program to further streamline the virtual signing of mediation agreements.

ODR saw the impact of the pandemic on its statistical data. For example, while mediations remained fairly stable from the previous year, a steeper decline was observed for due process requests.

While the continuing impact of the pandemic on special education dispute resolution is unknown, ODR will be working with a researcher to capture, analyze and report on observed future trends.

Finally, at the recommendation of the Special Education Advisory Panel (SEAP)<sup>4</sup>, effective March 1, 2021, attorneys have been permitted to participate in mediation if the parent chooses to bring an attorney. This procedure mirrors the role of attorneys in the resolution meeting session under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act<sup>5</sup>, as well as the practice in most other states. This adds another element to future statistical analysis, i.e., the relationship between attorneys participating in mediation sessions and agreement rates.

### **ODR Stakeholder Council**

The ODR Stakeholder Council (SC) brings together representatives from a broad array of stakeholders to provide functional input and recommendations on the special education dispute resolution system. Detailed biographical information

on each SC member is available on the ODR website<sup>6</sup>. The Council recently provided input to the Bureau of Special Education on suggested targets for mediation and resolution meeting agreement rates. ODR, with its Stakeholder Council, remains committed to encouraging mediation as an effective dispute resolution process, while continuing to recognize due process as an important procedural safeguard for parents.

## **Outreach**

Virtual presentations by ODR staff and hearing officers included: Special Education Leadership Academy; Technical Assistance for Excellence in Special Education (TAESE); Special Education Advisory Panel (SEAP); Pennsylvania Council for Exceptional Children (PACEC); Center for Appropriate Dispute Resolution in Special Education (CADRE); Pennsylvania Bar Institute, Allegheny Bar Association; Hispanos Unidos para Niños Excepcionales (HUNE), Arcs of Northeastern PA and Dauphin County; and various Intermediate Units, Early Intervention programs, and Local Task Force groups.

ODR staff produce videos, webinars, and podcasts on topics relevant to both parents and educators. Development of training products is an ongoing process and based upon identified stakeholder needs. During FY 20-21, ODR produced the following: an updated guide to mediation; a collaborative PaTTANpod video with the Parent Education & Advocacy Leadership (PEAL) Center and the Bureau of Special Education; and an ODR Overview video. Additionally, ODR's website was updated with increased focus on mediation and alternative dispute resolution.

## **Hearing Officer Training**

The hearing officers engage in rigorous professional development each year, both in-house and through highly regarded professional associations. During the fiscal year, hearing officers attended the following virtual trainings: LRP Institute; LRP Special Education School Attorneys Conference; Council of Parent Attorneys and Advocates Conference; National Association of Hearing Officials (NAHO); as

well as several trainings and webinars sponsored by the Pennsylvania Bar Institute. Additionally, during the COVID pandemic, hearing officers have also participated in webinars and trainings from various organizations related to special education.

## **ODR Projects**

### Hearing Officer Settlement Conferences

Since March 2017, Hearing Officer Settlement Conferences (HOSCs) have been a regularly offered service to parents and educators. ODR maintains a randomized list of HOSC hearing officer assignments. When parties request a HOSC, the next hearing officer on the list is assigned, after confirming that the hearing officer does not have an ongoing case with the parent or the LEA. If so, the next hearing officer on the list receives the assignment. Each hearing officer has a slightly different approach to the details of a HOSC, but the same general framework applies—a three-sided conversation between the settlement hearing officer and the attorneys (or LEA attorney and *pro se* parent) takes place. Thereafter, the settlement hearing officer typically has an individual conversation with each party. At that point, each HOSC moves in its own unique direction—sometimes resolution has been achieved, sometimes further three-sided conversations are held, and sometimes further individual conversations are held. The HOSC can continue until the parties feel it has met its goals, or the parties can continue without the settlement hearing officer. For this reporting period, there were 18 HOSC processes, resulting in an 83% settlement rate. This mirrors the overall 83% settlement rate since the inception of the program. The Special Education ConsultLine is a toll-free information helpline for parents and advocates who have questions or concerns about special education for school-age children. During FY 20-21, ODR’s Parent & Family Engagement Project officially merged with the Special Education ConsultLine (hereinafter “ConsultLine”). ConsultLine specialists now provide the same technical assistance to parents who are preparing to participate in mediation and IEP facilitation, and/or represent themselves in a due process hearing. ConsultLine is staffed by three specialists who provide information about special education, gifted education, and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973. Specialists assess the nature of the caller’s inquiry or concern and provide information and assistance.

The types of information provided include:

- The processes involved in having a child evaluated, identified, and provided with special education, accommodations, and related services;
- Parents’ rights and procedural safeguards, including information about regulations;
- Dispute resolution services and options for resolving disagreements about a child’s special education program;
- The process and procedures of a caller’s active case related to IEP Facilitation, Mediation, and Due Process Hearing;
- Information, assistance, and access to the state complaint process managed by the Pennsylvania Department of Education’s Bureau of Special Education (BSE); and
- Resources, publications, websites, and referrals to disability-related organizations

Specialists respond to requests for information by calling the individual directly. In an attempt to speak with everyone who has requested information, Specialists call individuals at least three times over the course of three business days. This has been an effective protocol for providing service in an equitable and timely manner.

Further, ODR continues to strive to make itself more accessible to its constituents by developing a Live Chat feature that is operated by the ConsultLine Specialists. Live Chat allows constituents to ask questions in real time with a specialist Monday through Friday, from 8:30AM to 4PM regarding any ODR services. After hours, constituents can fill out a ticket to request a follow-up phone call the next business day (or at the date and time the constituent designates). Live Chat has been operational since July 15, 2021.

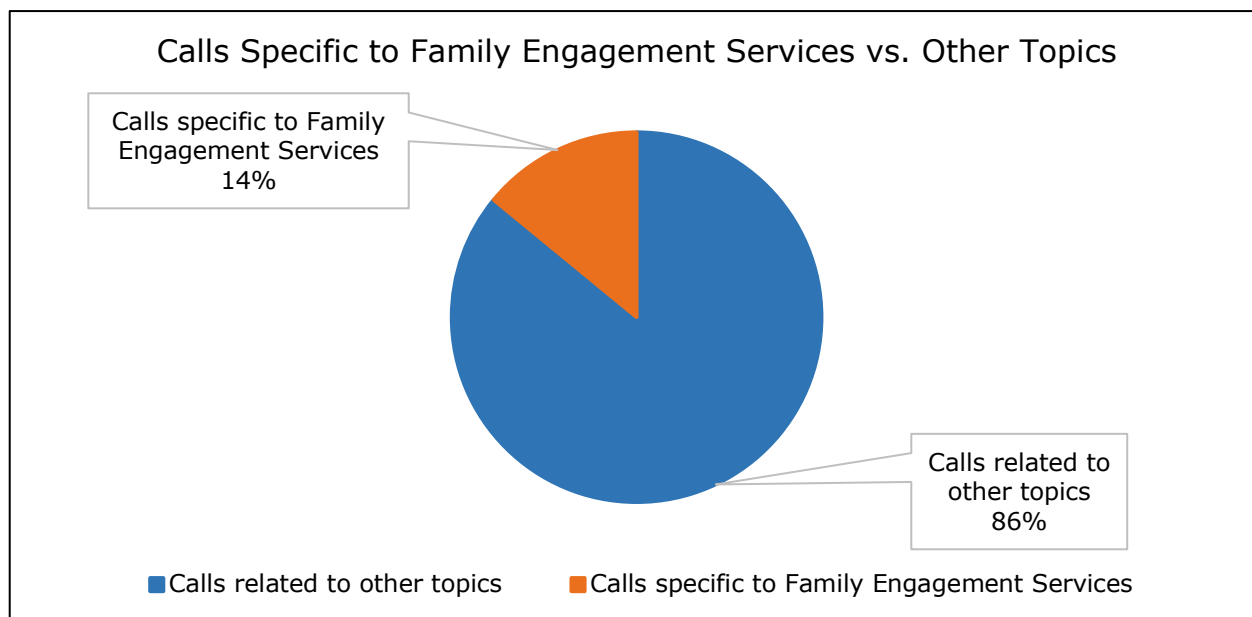
ConsultLine Specialists work diligently behind the scenes to ensure that all constituents have access to the most updated and accurate information and resources:

- Ensuring that Hearing Officer decisions have all personally identifiable information removed and that the decisions meet accessibility standards prior to posting on ODR's website;
- Maintaining the Parent Resource Library section of ODR's website;
- Conducting group presentations for interested stakeholders via in-person or virtual sessions on the function, purpose, and services of ODR. This includes an ODR Overview training specific to Early Intervention dispute resolution;
- Collaborating with PaTTAN to ensure the OSEP Policy Letter database remains up to date; and
- Collaborating with the Center for Schools and Communities on Family Engagement activities

## Call Activity

During FY 20-21, ConsultLine Specialists served 1,901 constituents, including 16 callers who spoke Spanish via a third-party interpretation service. ConsultLine received 168 calls related to COVID-19 and its impact on special education. Specialists receive contacts via the ConsultLine/Family Engagement voicemail, email, and online contact form. Out of the 1,901 callers served, 311 were specific to Family Engagement services.

ConsultLine developed and implement several new initiatives during the reporting period. These included the official merger of ConsultLine with Parent & Family Engagement and the launch of the Live Chat feature (both detailed above). Additionally, under Family Engagement, specialists began outreach to parties when their recent mediation resulted in no agreement. This often times provides more detailed feedback as to why parties thought an agreement could not be reached, and informs mediation training moving forward. Similarly, to improve upon ODR's stakeholder responsibilities, ConsultLine specialists have begun to follow up with respondents from the Dispute Resolution Survey to further discuss any comments, suggestions and/or concerns about their recent IEP facilitation or due process hearing.

**Regional Representation of Inquiries**

Regional information was volunteered during 873 calls during FY 20-21.

ConsultLine received the highest volume of calls from the following regions:

**Types of Inquiries**

ConsultLine Specialists document the main topics associated with a caller’s question(s). During FY 20-21, the most regularly recurring topics, in order of frequency, pertained to the following:

Other high interest topics included multidisciplinary evaluation process; educational placement; notice; procedural safeguards; and IEP facilitation. Specialists provided publications, forms, web resources and other materials related to the caller’s interests in 758 instances. The majority of this information was delivered electronically.



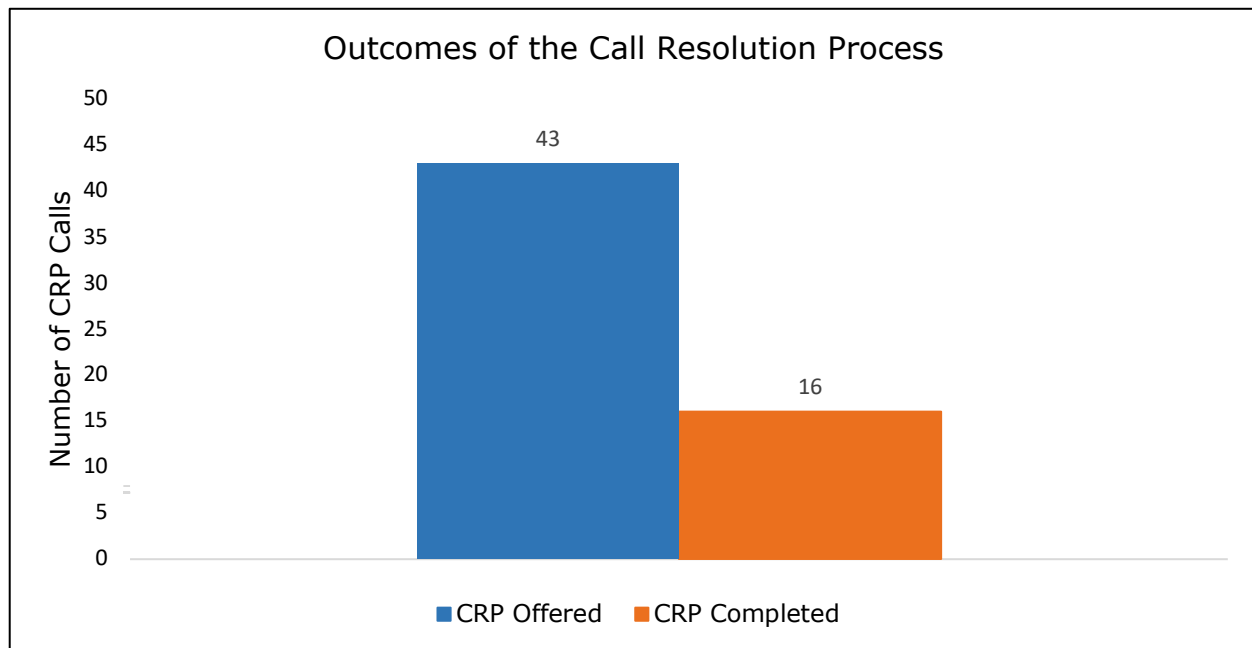
## **Call Resolution Process and Provision of BSE Complaint Packets**

ConsultLine's Call Resolution Process (CRP) is an effective dispute resolution tool for compliance-related concerns for IDEA-related issues and certain types of concerns related to Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973. During CRP, the Specialist acts as a conduit of information between the parent (as defined in 34 CFR 16 § 300.30) and the school; the Specialist does not serve as an advocate, decision maker, mediator, or compliance advisor.

The CRP format and process includes an email summarizing the parent's compliance-related concerns, and to the extent known, the parent's proposed resolution. The email is prepared by the Specialist in consultation with the parent so that the message accurately reflects the parent's concern. Once the message is drafted and reviewed with the parent, the parent provides verbal permission to send the message to the LEA administrator responsible for special education; BSE division chief; and the regional BSE advisor. Once this email has been sent, the Specialist's involvement in CRP has concluded.

During FY 20-21, CRP was offered to 43 callers, and distributed with the parent's permission in 16 instances. Common reasons for declining the distribution of the CRP were the parent wanting to speak/meet with the school one more time to try to resolve the issue before sending the CRP, or the parent wanting to speak with the other parent/advocate before agreeing to send the CRP. The most frequent issue in a CRP was IEP implementation.

Information about the BSE complaint process and the state complaint form is sent to the parent when CRP has been offered, and also when specifically requested by the caller. During FY 20-21, 63 state complaint forms and information packets were distributed to callers.

### **Gifted Education**

ConsultLine Specialists assist callers who have questions or concerns about Chapter 16/gifted education. Some of these callers allege compliance violations. When this occurs, the Specialist provides the caller with information about the procedural safeguards for gifted education, including the option to file a written complaint. During FY 20-21, ConsultLine responded to 43 callers whose questions or concerns were specifically related to gifted education. Of those 43 callers, 16 were specific to questions or concerns related to their active due process hearing, mediation, or GIEP facilitation.

### **ConsultLine Feedback**

When callers provide contact information, Specialists conclude service by mailing or emailing an evaluation survey to the caller. The survey is brief, and it can be completed and returned anonymously. Survey participants are asked to

provide comments and to answer several satisfaction-based questions. Survey respondents assess the following areas: usefulness of information; identifying options for resolving concerns; timeliness of service; and general satisfaction. For FY 20-21, survey results show that ConsultLine continues to maintain a high level of satisfaction from constituents.

## **Professional Development**

ConsultLine staff continue to participate in high quality professional development opportunities to remain well informed and effective in conveying useful information and relevant resources to callers. During FY 20-21, professional development activities included the LRP National Institute; Pennsylvania Bar Institute's Exceptional Children Conference; and Lehigh University's Special Education Law Symposium. ConsultLine staff have also participated in many webinars and training related to special education during the COVID pandemic. Additionally, specialists are involved in outreach activities and collaboration with cross-agency staff on various ODR, BSE, and CADRE initiatives.



## **IEP Facilitation**

ODR provides two types of facilitation: IEP/IFSP/GIEP/Section 504 facilitation and resolution meeting facilitation. Both types of facilitation are voluntary, meaning it can only be used when all parties agree that the presence of a neutral third party would help facilitate communication and the successful drafting of the student's IEP/GIEP or a resolution agreement (in the case of resolution meeting facilitation). Typically, this process is not necessary for most IEP meetings or resolution meetings. Rather, it is most often utilized when there is a sense from any of the participants that the issues at the meeting are creating an impasse or acrimonious climate.

## **Resolution Meeting Facilitation**

During FY 20-21, ODR received one request for a facilitator to attend a resolution meeting. The parties and facilitator reached partial agreement at the meeting.

## **IFSP Facilitation (Birth-3)**

There were no requests for IFSP facilitation during FY 20-21.

## **IEP/GIEP/Section 504 Facilitation Requests**

In FY 20-21, there were 69 requests for IEP Facilitation. There was one IEP Facilitation request that was carried over from FY 19-20, bringing the total number of facilitation requests being reported to 70. Consistent with prior years, the overwhelming majority of these cases (65) pertained to school aged students and their IEPs. Of the five remaining requests, one request was for the IEP of a child aged 3-5 and four requests were for GIEP facilitation. There were no requests for 504 Plan facilitation this fiscal year.

For requests pertaining to school aged students, the parent declined to participate in IEP Facilitation in five cases, and the school declined to participate in four cases. In 13 cases, the request for facilitation was withdrawn. Two requests remained active at the close of the reporting period.

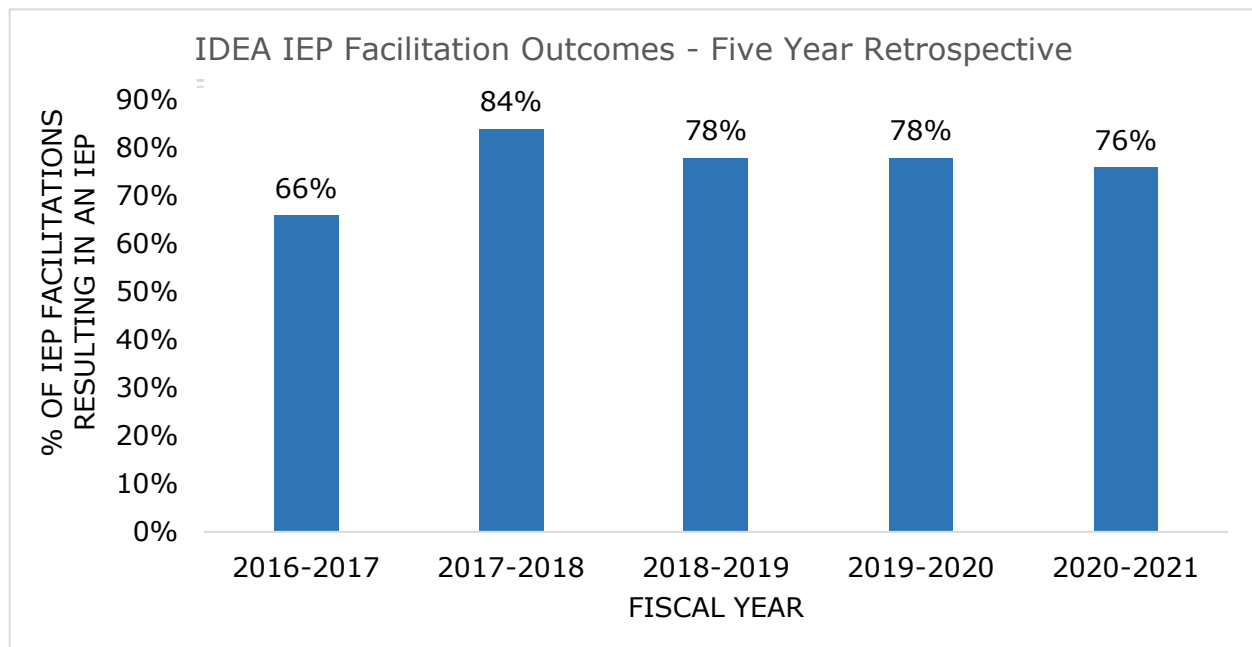
For gifted IEP facilitation, the LEA declined to participate two times. In one case, the request for facilitation was withdrawn.

### **IEP Facilitation Outcomes – IDEA**

For the one facilitation which took place regarding a child aged 3-5, the IEP team was not successful in writing an IEP with the assistance of a facilitator. There were 41 school aged IEP facilitations held in FY 20-21. An IEP was written during 21 of the facilitated IEP meetings and a partial IEP was written in 11 of the facilitated IEP meetings. In nine cases the IEP was not agreed upon even with the assistance and support of a facilitator.

Figure 4 displays the most recent five-year history of results of IEP Facilitations. After achieving a high of 84% of facilitations resulting in a complete IEP being written, the observed rate has been consistently above 75%.

## **GIEP – Outcomes**

There were four requests for GIEP Facilitation, with one moving forward to a GIEP meeting with a facilitator. The team was successful in writing a GIEP with the facilitator's assistance.



## Introduction

For the decade preceding the pandemic, some general trends in special education dispute resolution have emerged, both nationally and within Pennsylvania. CADRE released ten years<sup>8</sup> of national mediation data, including the total number of mediation requests nationwide, followed by the subset of mediations actually held, and the even smaller subset of mediation agreements reached. While there has been some fluctuation in the data, for the most part, mediation requests have increased in the past decade, mediation sessions held have stayed fairly constant, as have mediation agreement rates.

The following charts show mediation activity per 10,000 students both nationally (Table 4) and within Pennsylvania (Table 5).

CADRE's national data collection demonstrates that national dispute resolution activity is not monolithic. For example, in its *IDEA Data Brief: Mediation*<sup>9</sup> CADRE states, in pertinent part:

*Mediation activity varied significantly across states, with 17 states receiving few or no requests for mediation... Six states and entities consistently receive no request for mediation, and eleven consistently receive ten or fewer requests per year.*

Thus, while strict comparisons cannot be made among all states in the country, looking at states with similar characteristics to Pennsylvania provides some insight. Pennsylvania is a member of the 7-PAK Consortium of Large States<sup>10</sup> - those states with the largest number of children and students receiving special education services. When comparing Pennsylvania to the 7-PAK, our rate of dispute resolution activity is comparable as evident in the following three comparison charts<sup>11</sup>:

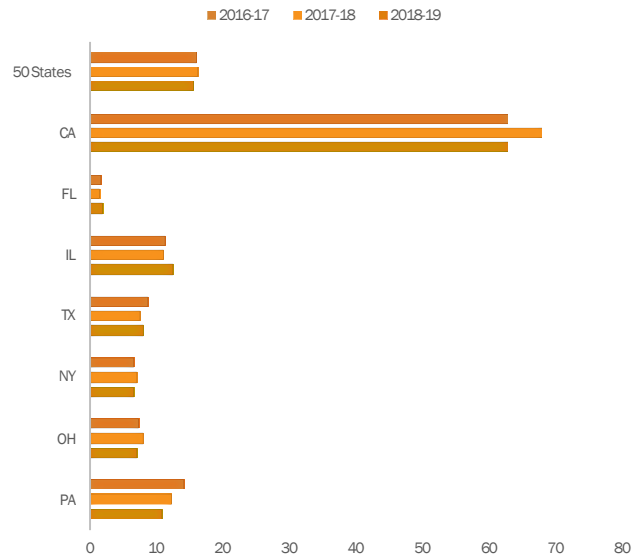

Figure 5: Mediation Requests per 10K for 7-PAK States

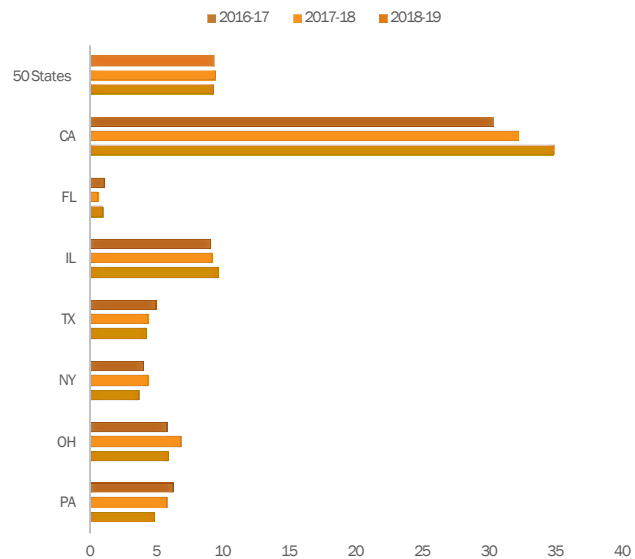
## Mediation Requests per 10K for 7-PAK States



Pennsylvania ranks third among 7-PAK states in the number of mediation requests per 10,000 students with disabilities over the past three years. California leads this group by a very wide margin.

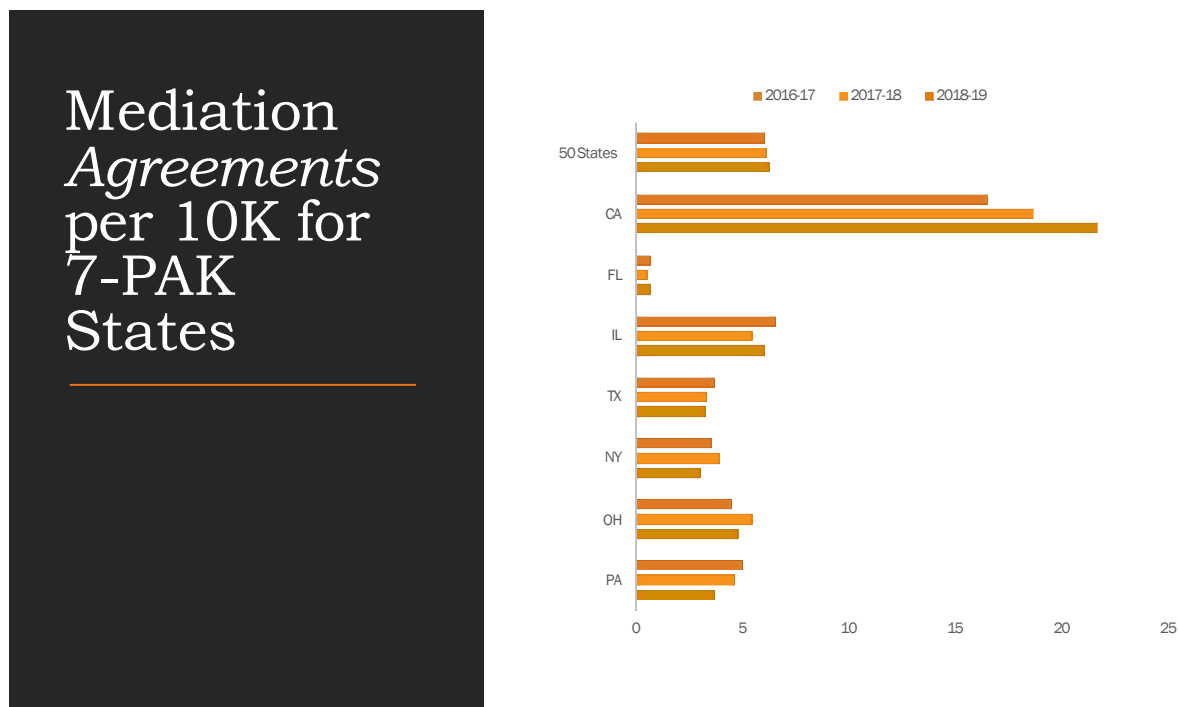
Figure 6: Mediations Held per 10K for 7-PAK States

## Mediations Held per 10K for 7-PAK States



Pennsylvania ranks fourth among 7-PAK states in the number of mediations held per 10,000 students with disabilities over the past three years. Again, California leads this group by a very wide margin, which is expected since the number of requests far surpasses the remaining 7-PAK states.

Pennsylvania ranks fourth among 7-PAK states in the number of mediation agreements per 10,000 students with disabilities over the past three years. Again, it is not unexpected that California leads this group since it held the most mediations.

Pennsylvania lands solidly in the middle of the 7-PAK states for these three mediation measures. Efforts to encourage mediations as a vehicle for dispute resolution between parents and LEAs have led to encouraging outcomes.

### Mediation Outreach and Training

Over the last several years, including FY 20-21, ODR has been actively engaged in activities to promote the use of mediation. To raise awareness about mediation and share the benefits of the service, ODR has provided virtual live trainings throughout FY 20-21. These have included trainings to several LEA groups and special education administrators about mediation by an ODR contracted

mediator. ODR has also reached out to Local Task Force groups and other organizations to offer presentations about available ODR services. ODR has presented to 11 of these groups in FY 20-21, with additional trainings scheduled for FY 21-22. ODR has presented to the Pennsylvania Virtual Fellowship Academy to share information about mediation and other dispute resolution options with special education leaders.

ODR has made multimedia improvements and additions as part of this mediation campaign. The new ODR website went live at the beginning of FY 20-21 with an increased focus on mediation and alternatives to due process. Several videos have been produced to promote mediation; some were a collaboration with stakeholders. These included a video with HUNE, a PaTTANpod video with ODR, PEAL, and BSE, and a recording of the ODR Overview training frequently presented to parent and LEA groups. Additionally, several of ODR's publications have been reviewed and updated with the mediation campaign in mind.

To ensure ODR is offering high-quality mediation services, ODR's contracted mediators participate in professional development throughout the year, related to both special education and mediation practices. In FY 20-21, ODR sponsored a training for all ODR mediators with a focus on agreement writing and attorney participation at mediation. Mediators also participated in the PA Council of Mediators Pre-Conference session, the Technical Assistance for Excellence in Special Education National Mediator Training, the Pennsylvania Department of Education Conference, various webinars through the Center for Appropriate Dispute Resolution in Special Education, and bi-monthly Community of Practice calls with peers.

The Special Education ConsultLine specialists have become more involved with the mediation process, with the goal of increasing a family's understanding of mediation. All families who are participating in mediation without an attorney are contacted by a ConsultLine specialist when a new mediation request is submitted. Specialists can explain the mediation process, provide information related to the mediation issues, and answer any questions the family may have. This additional knowledge can help to assist families in becoming more informed participants in the

process. When a mediation session is held that does not result in a mediation agreement, ConsultLine specialists reach out to the family to hear their perspective on why an agreement was not reached. Moving forward, ConsultLine will also include LEA representatives and attorneys (if attorneys were present at the mediation) in the outreach efforts in order to obtain a diverse perspective. This information will be used to learn more about any barriers that prevented an agreement and to monitor training needs.

### **Attorney Participation at Mediation**

Mediation in Pennsylvania underwent a significant change in March 2021, with the addition of attorney participation under certain circumstances. Since the inception of Pennsylvania's special education mediation program in 1986, attorneys had not been permitted to attend or participate in mediation in any way.

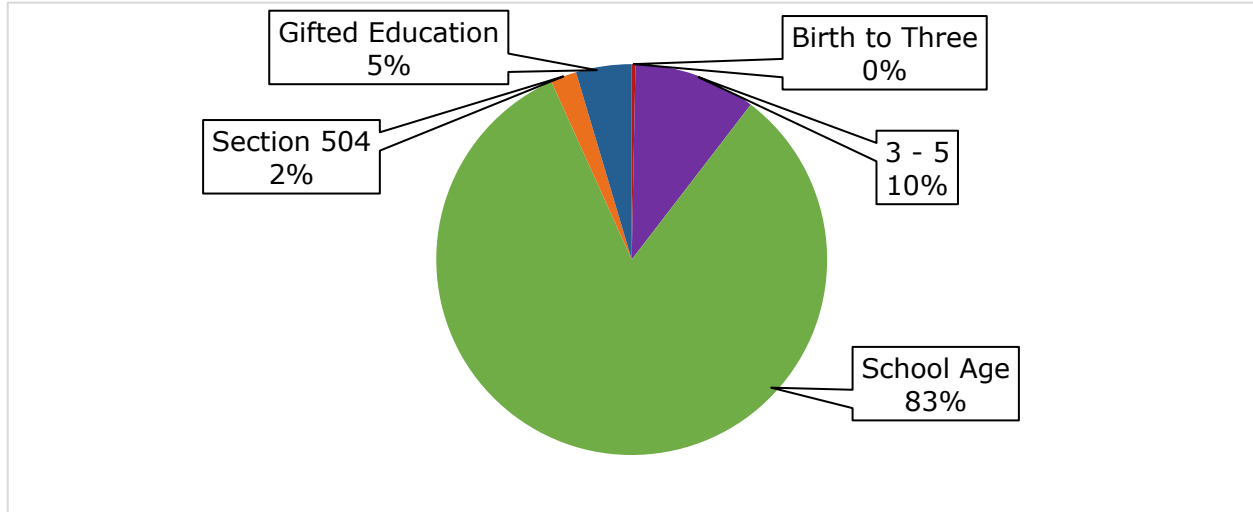
During the 20-21 fiscal year, the Special Education Advisory Panel endorsed a change in this longstanding policy, recommending that the Commonwealth follow the process for attorney participation at resolution meetings. As of March 1, 2021, if the family chooses to bring an attorney to mediation, the LEA may also bring counsel. If the family chooses not to have counsel, the LEA likewise does not bring counsel. It is noteworthy that prior to this change, Pennsylvania was one of only four states that did not allow attorneys at mediation.

The addition of attorneys at mediation occurred late in the fiscal year, so there is not sufficient data to determine the impact of this change. From March 1-June 30, 2021, 39 mediation requests involved attorneys. Of those, 13 proceeded to a mediation session. A mediation agreement was reached in five cases and mediation was not successful in eight cases. Of those eight unsuccessful mediations, three moved on to a due process hearing. All three due process cases were active at the close of this reporting period.

## Summary of Mediation Data

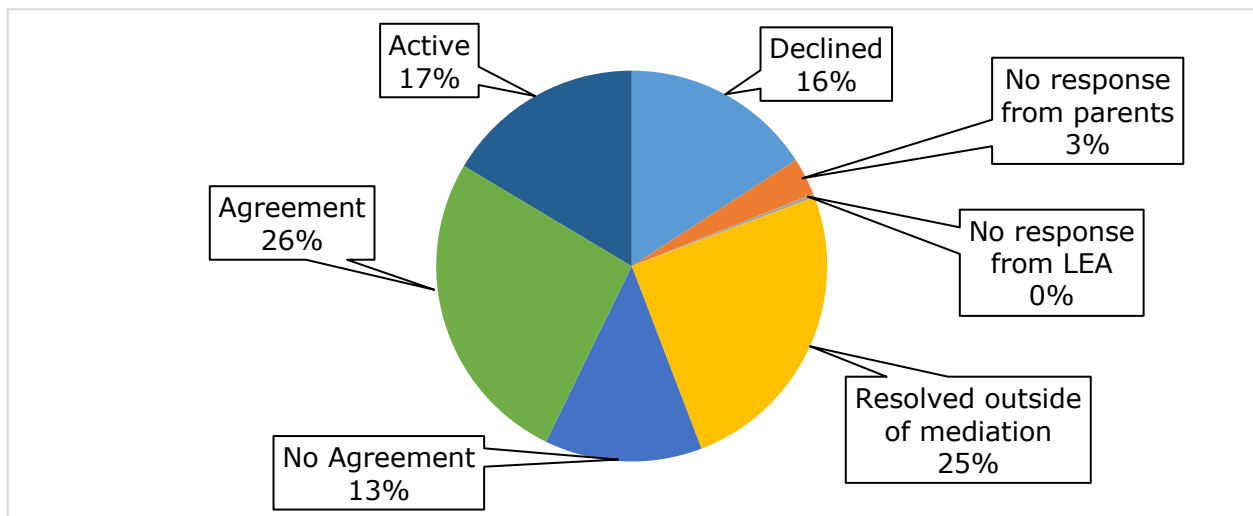
ODR received a total of 326 mediation requests during FY 20-21.

Twenty-seven requests were carried over from FY 19-20, for a total of 353 mediation outcomes being reported for this fiscal year, the vast majority of which were related to school age issues. Approximately half of the outcomes were either reported as agreements (26%) or resolved outside of mediation (25%).

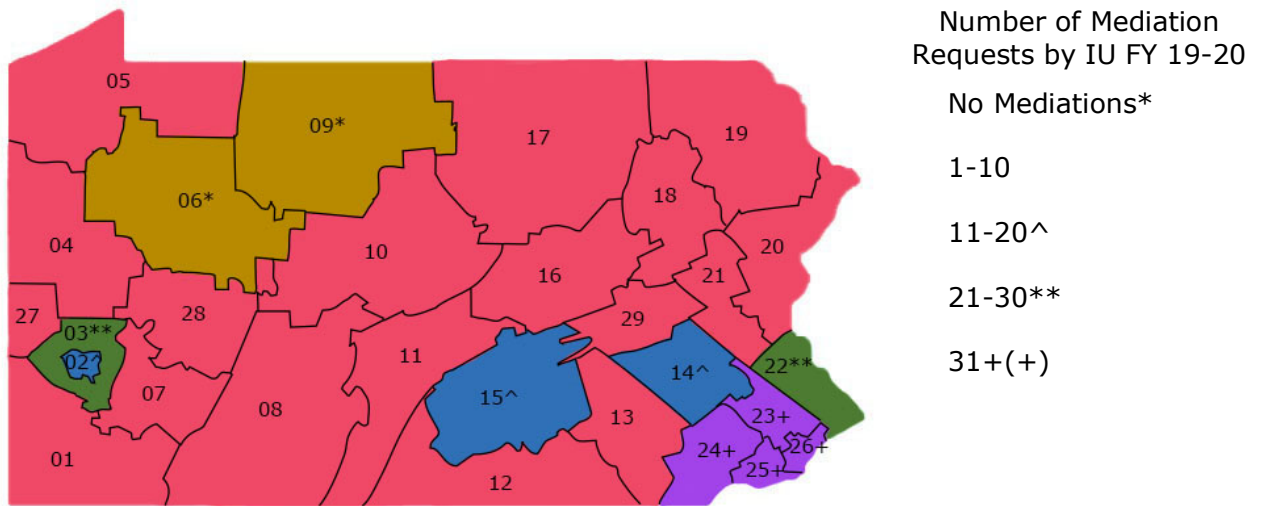
Figure 9: Total Mediation Request Outcomes

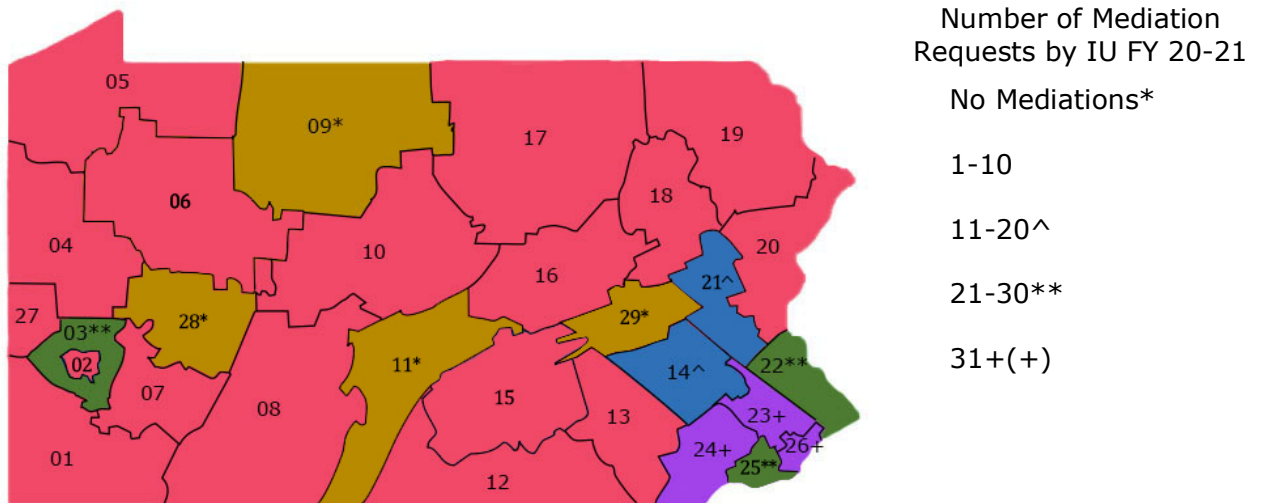

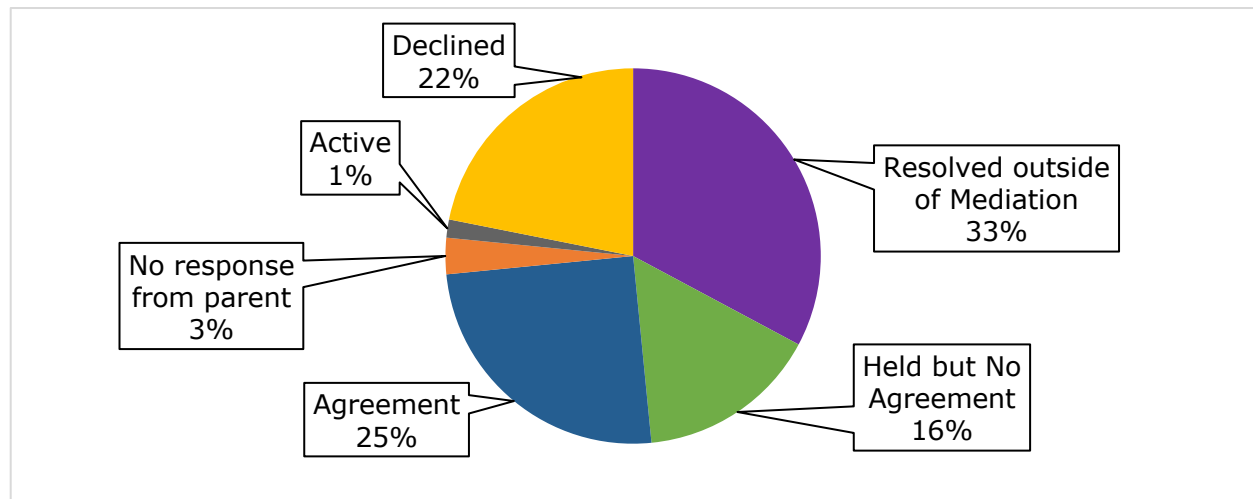
## Mediation Issues

### **Mediation Results by Age and Category**

Mediation is a voluntary process, and therefore, neither families nor LEAs are obligated to agree to participate, nor are they required to report the reason for their refusal to participate. This makes it challenging to assess why mediation is utilized in some instances and not others. As to mediation agreement rates, mediation participants are encouraged to complete post mediation surveys in order to provide useful information to ODR on training needs. As noted above, ConsultLine reaches out to participants when mediation is not successful to learn more about why the mediation did not achieve its goals, as well as to provide additional information to parents on dispute resolution options.

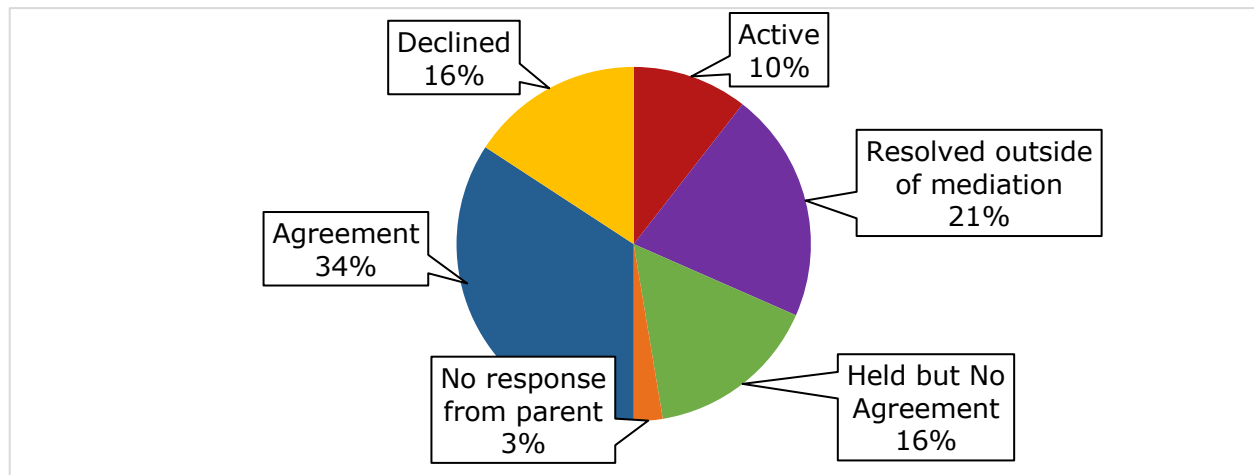

Figure 13: 3-5 Mediation Outcomes

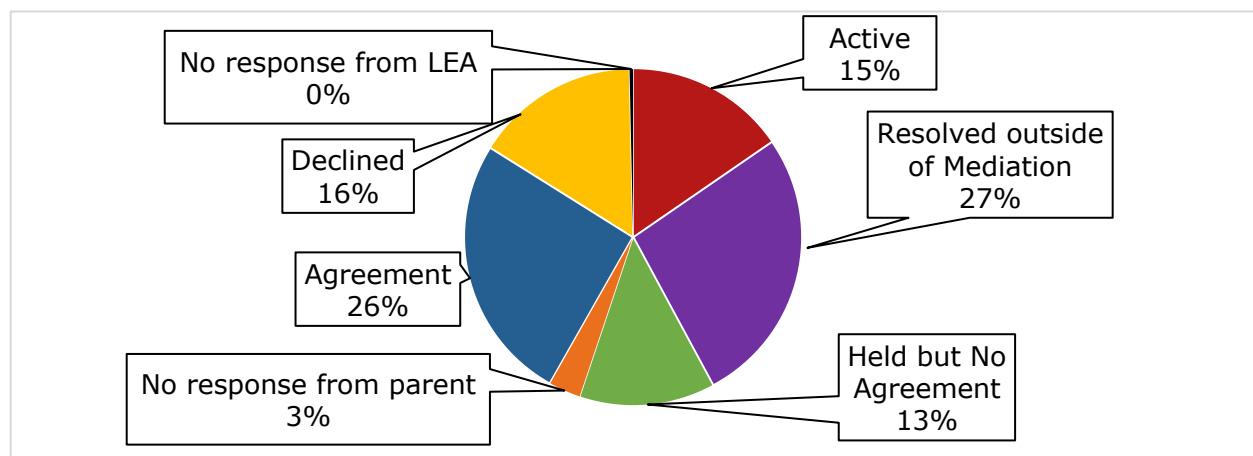

Figure 14: School Age Mediation Outcomes

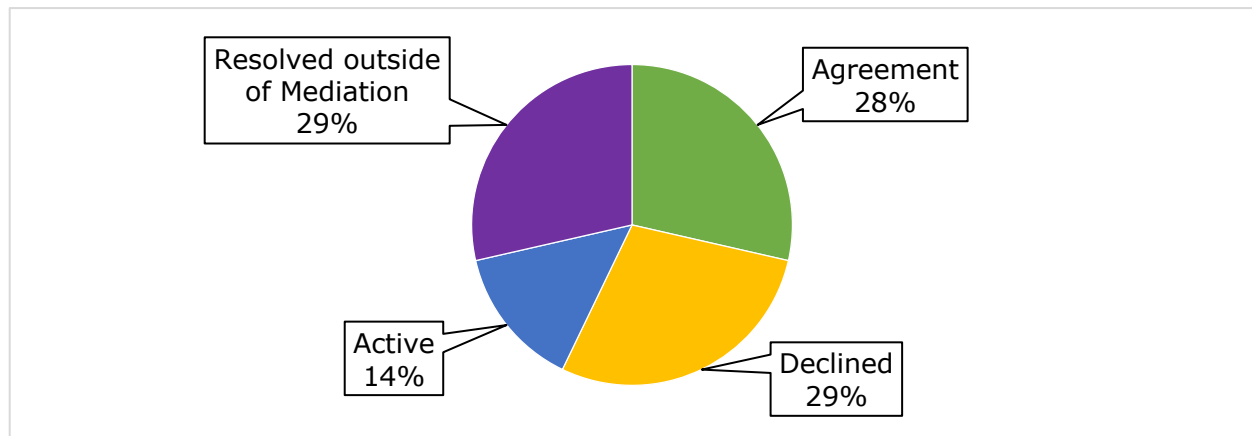

Figure 15: Section 504/Chapter 15 Mediation Outcomes

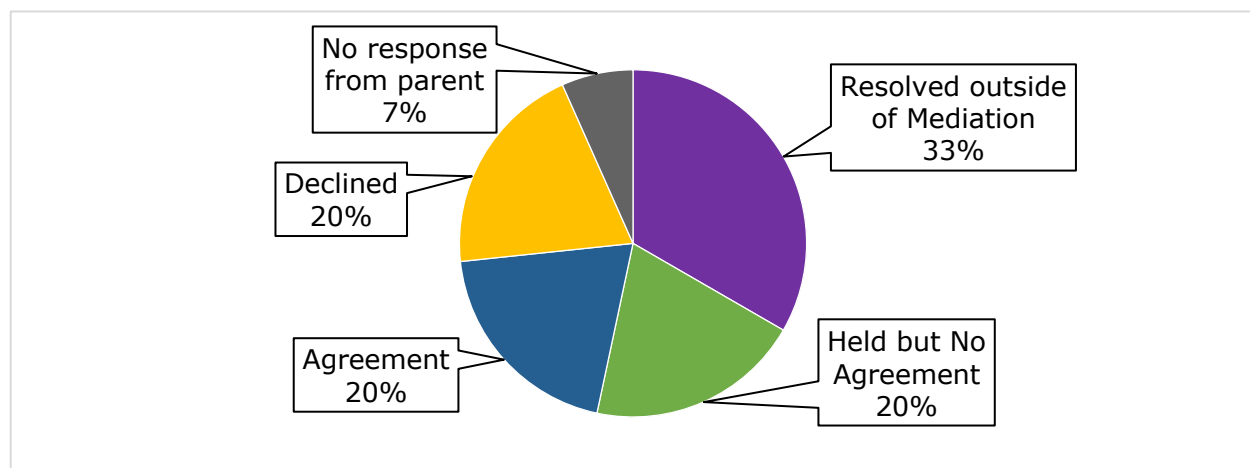

Overall, 33% of mediations held for gifted education disputes were resolved outside of mediation and 20% resulted in an agreement between parties.

### Mediation Agreement Rates

In FY 19-20, the mediation agreement rate was 73% and in FY 20-21 the mediation agreement rate was 67%. Several mediators provided their perspectives on the decline in the proportion of agreements at mediation. A common perspective offered was related to the issue at the heart of the mediation. Those mediations with issues that were polarizing and/or involved a financial cost, such as private school placement, were anecdotally reported as being less likely to result in an agreement. Mediators also described fewer agreements when the issue was related

to COVID-19 health and safety, such as allowing in-person schooling or providing services in the student’s home. These decisions were reported to be outside the LEA representatives’ hands and were determined by state or local mandates and decisions.

Mediators reported the switch to virtual mediations due to the COVID-19 pandemic made some mediations more difficult to conduct due to participants’ discomfort with the virtual platform, time constraints, and the inability to “read the room” as well as one could during an in-person mediation. While it is likely that these initial challenges diminished as mediators and participants became more accustomed to virtual technologies, the idea that the movement to the virtual format resulted in fewer mediation agreements is plausible. Several mediators also referenced the climate of the country was generally one of less agreement and felt that trickled into some mediation sessions.

Mediators reported that even when parties did not agree to a written mediation agreement, there was often some movement toward agreement made during the mediation session. While these smaller forms of agreement may not have been documented in a mediation agreement, they demonstrate that while a mediation looks “unsuccessful” on paper, it has often times moved the dispute forward toward resolution.

## **Due Process Requests**

Parents or educational agencies may also resolve educational disputes through a mechanism called due process. Due process differs from other dispute resolution opportunities in that a Hearing Officer decides the dispute for the parties. Throughout the due process proceedings, resolution through mediation remains available to the parties. In addition, during the proceedings the parties may settle some or all of the issues among themselves at any time, and in most instances, do so.

As reported in last year's Annual Report, ODR had observed an upward trend in due process requests in the past several years and was working with a researcher to attempt to identify, from a statistical perspective, reasons why this was occurring. The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania was on track to exceed the number of due process requests from FY 18-19 (1,000) when the COVID-19 shutdown occurred. During FY 19-20, ODR received 998 requests for due process, with schools closed for approximately three months of the reporting period because of the coronavirus pandemic. It is expected that this number would have exceeded the previous year had the shutdown not occurred, and, it is believed, at least temporarily, suspended parties from making requests for ODR services.

During FY 20-21, which spans the ongoing pandemic, ODR received 851 requests for due process hearings<sup>13</sup>, 147 fewer than FY 19-20, and 149 fewer than FY 18-19. At the same time, as noted in the Mediation section above, while mediation requests decreased by 41, the decline was not as steep as the decline in due process requests. ODR will be continuing its work with a researcher to discern

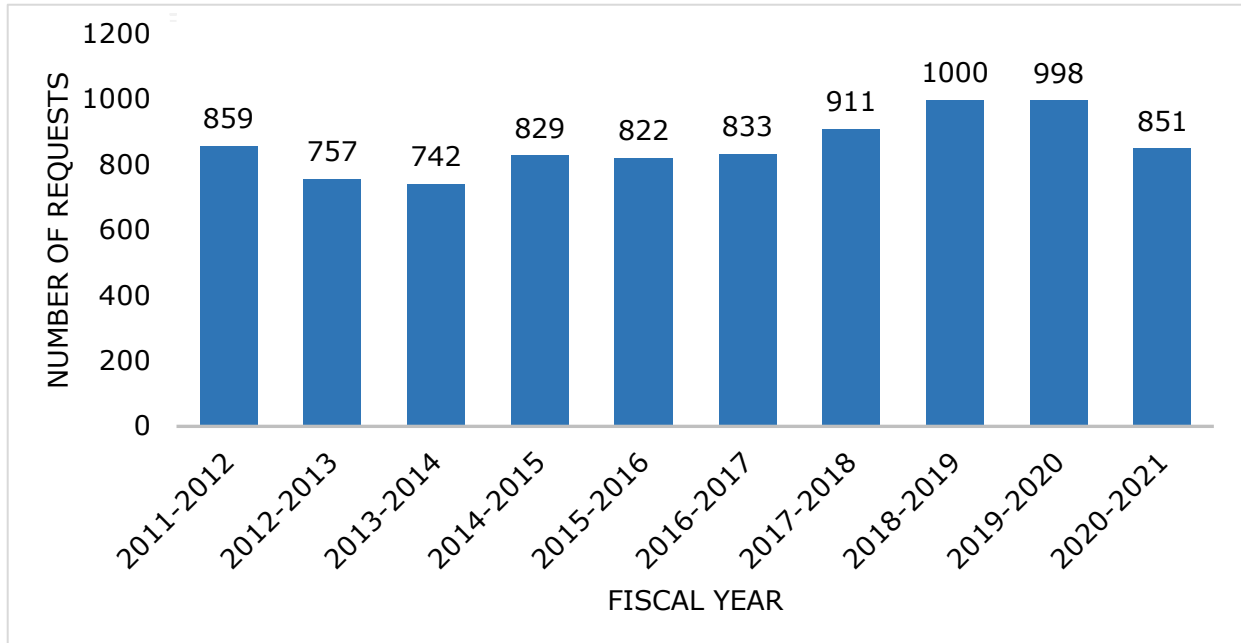

Figure 18: Due Process Requests – 3-5

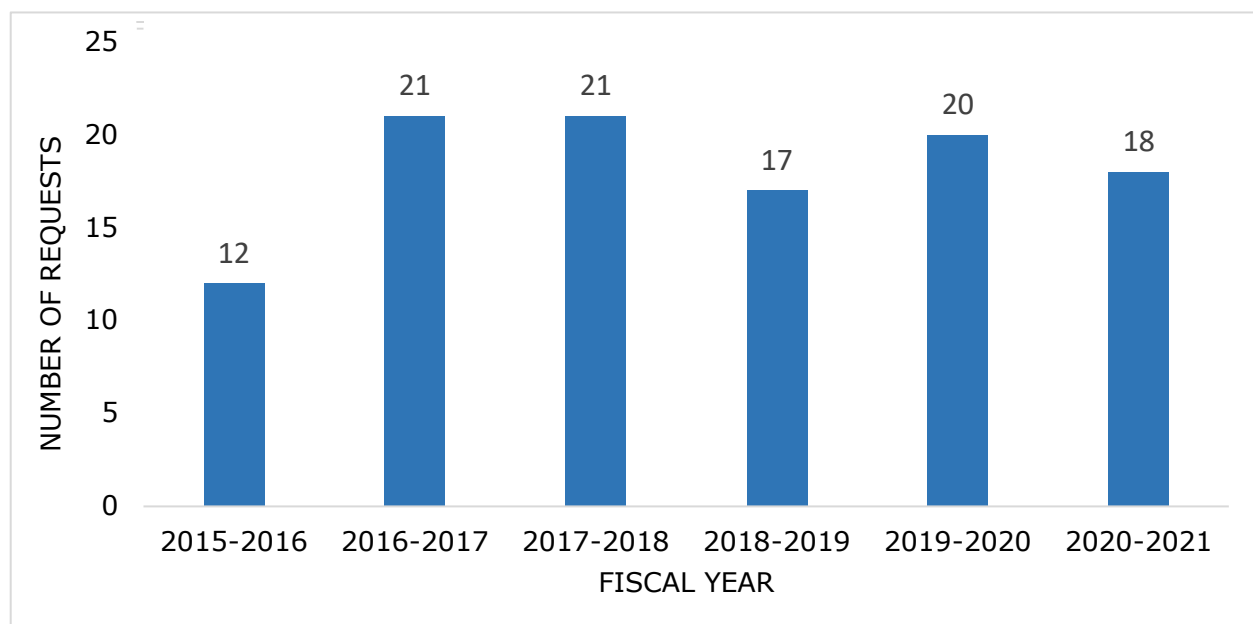


Figure 19: Due Process Requests – School Age

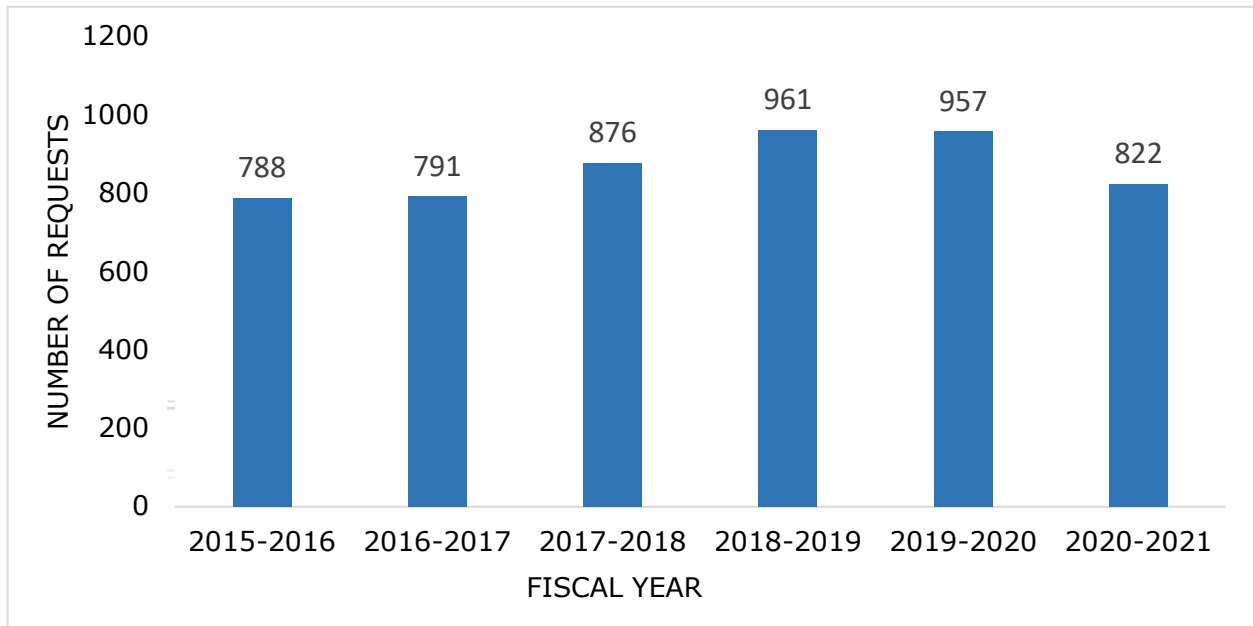


Figure 20: Due Process Requests – Section 504

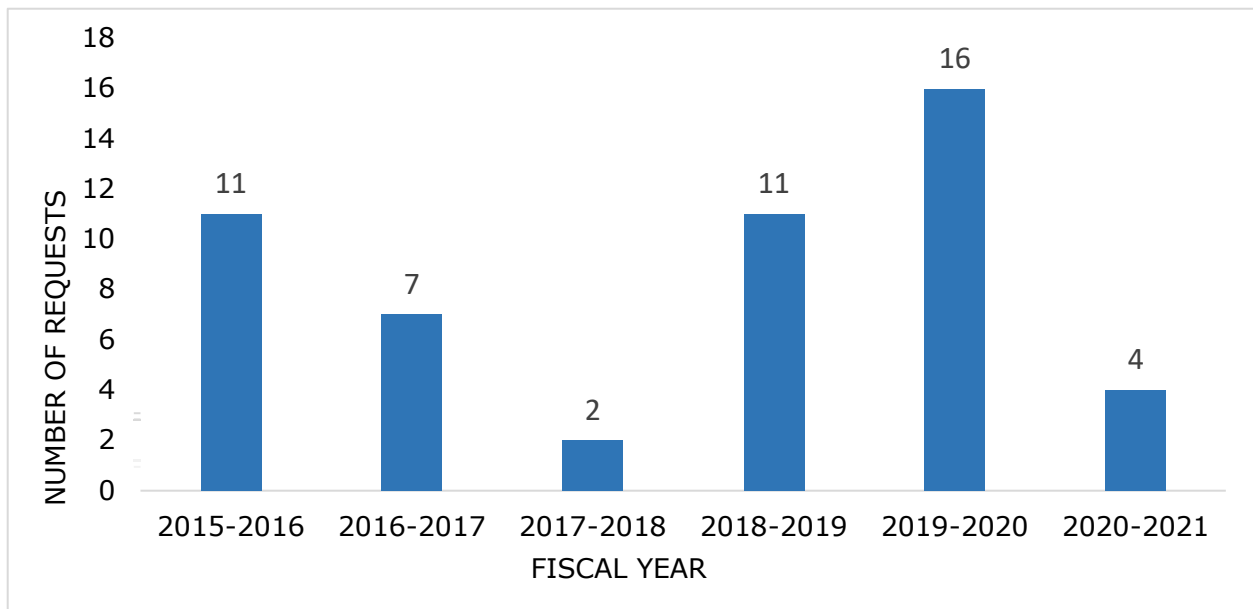
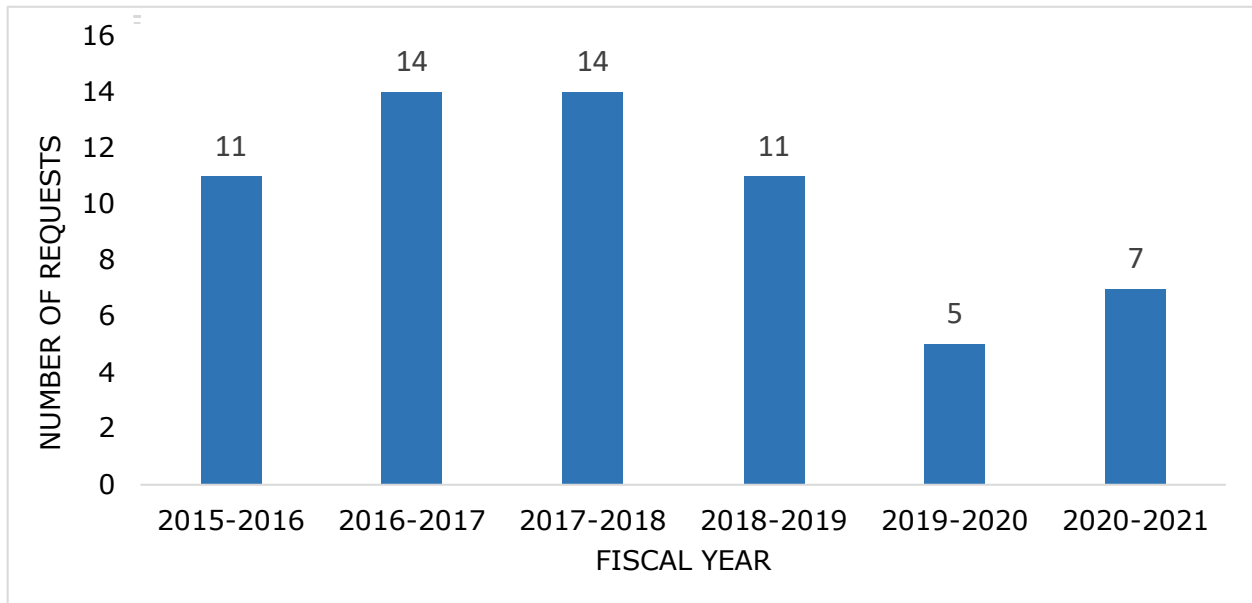


Figure 21: Due Process Requests – Gifted Education



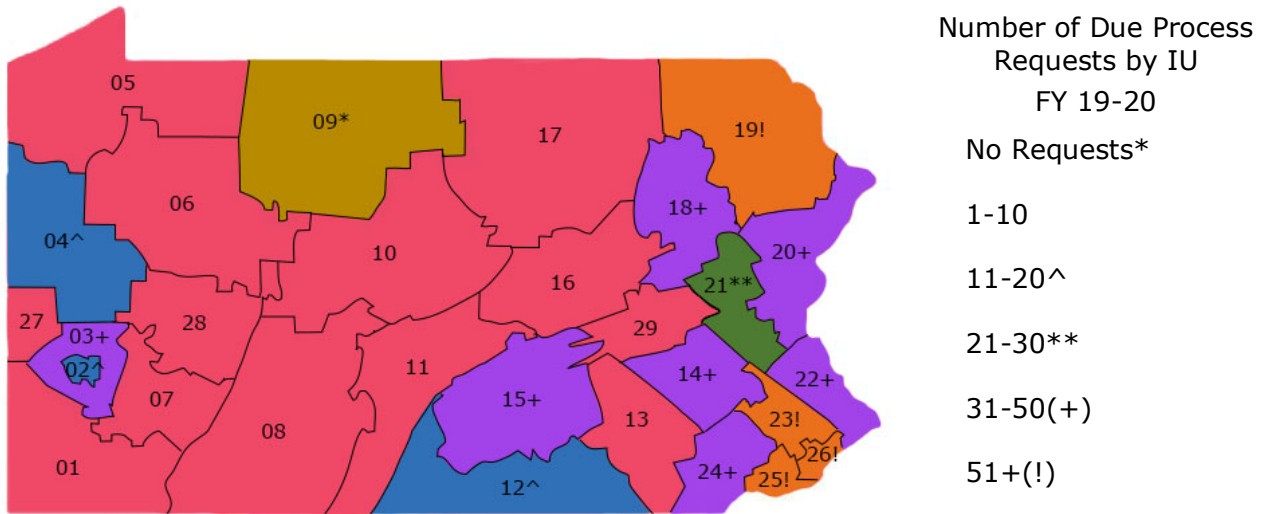
### Frequency of Due Process Across the Commonwealth

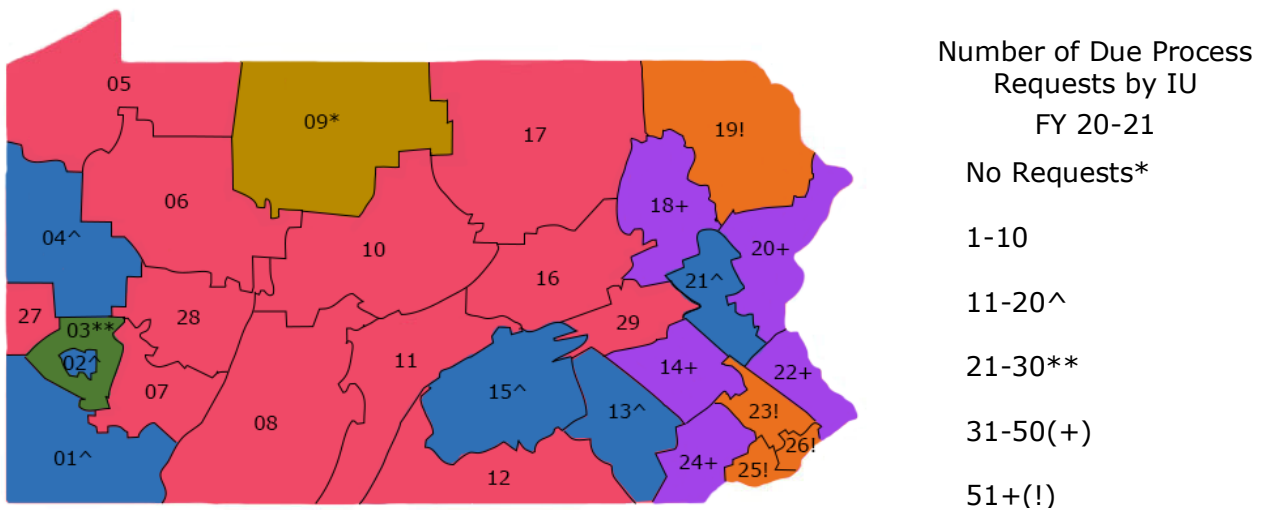

## **Due Process Outcomes**

### Requests

A total of 851 requests were received during FY 20-21. A total of 172 requests from FY 19-20 and one request from FY 18-19 carried over into the current fiscal year. The outcomes of these cases are as follows:

### Settlement or Withdrawal

#### *FY 20-21 cases*

In 594 cases, the parties reached agreement without the need for a fully adjudicated hearing. Only 19 cases went to at least one hearing before settling. In 58 cases, the parties reported a withdrawal of the request without specifying the reason for the withdrawal (e.g., settlement, dropping of the request, etc.).

#### *FY 19-20 cases*

In 118 cases, the parties reached agreement without the need for a fully adjudicated hearing. Only eight cases went to at least one hearing before settling. In six cases, the parties reported a withdrawal of the request without specifying the reason for the withdrawal.

## Appeals to State and Federal Court

During FY 20-21, there were 21 appeals to state or federal court; only three of these appeals pertained to FY 20-21 requests for hearing, with the balance pre-dating the reporting period. The appellant chose federal court in all but one instance. Parents accounted for 95% of the total number of appeals received. As of the close of the reporting period, 19 cases were still in progress. The Court ruled on the substantive aspect of the case in two instances, affirming the hearing officers' decisions in their entirety.
