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Through the Office for Dispute Resolution (ODR), the Pennsylvania Department of Education (PDE) fulfills its statutory mandate to maintain a special education due process system. PDE contracts with the Central Susquehanna Intermediate Unit (CSIU) to provide fiscal and certain management support for that office, without becoming involved in substantive operations. The hearing officers and mediators are free from interference or influence on any matters affecting the outcome of individual mediations and due process hearings. This includes, without limitation, interference, or influence from any entity, individual, or group, such as parents, advocacy groups, school districts, intermediate units including CSIU, ODR staff, and PDE. At the same time, those hearing officers and mediators are provided with administrative support, as well as training delivered in a manner preserving their impartiality through ODR, which itself is also free of such interference or influence.

The Central Susquehanna Intermediate Unit will not discriminate in educational programs, activities or employment practices based on race, color, national origin, gender, disability, marital status, age, religion, sexual orientation, ancestry, union membership or other legally protected classifications. Announcement of this policy is in accord with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972, Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, and the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990. 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INTRODUCTION

This Annual Report contains dispute resolution information from the Office for Dispute Resolution (ODR), and, for the first time, state complaint data from the Bureau of Special Education (BSE). Including state complaint data allows the Annual Report to provide comprehensive information on all special education dispute resolution options in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, whether by BSE or ODR.

The Office for Dispute Resolution provides the resources for parents¹ and local educational agencies (LA/LEAs) to resolve educational disputes involving children served by the early intervention system, students with disabilities (or thought to have disabilities) and students who are gifted (or thought to be gifted). Pennsylvania’s recognition as an “exemplar state” by the Office for Special Education Programs (OSEP) and the Center for Appropriate Dispute Resolution in Special Education (CADRE) is an acknowledgement of the experience, education, and training of ODR staff² and the quality of ODR services provided.³ In addition to its website, publications, and videos, ODR remains in contact with its stakeholders through a listserv. ODR’s listserv is available at <https://odr-pa.org/subscribe-to-odr/>.

During the COVID-19 shutdown, ODR provided

all its services in a virtual format. There has now been a return to in-person facilitations, mediations, and due process, but nowhere near pre-pandemic levels. In due process in particular, the hearing officer and parties may meet in person for one session and meet virtually for another. The option also exists for one or more parties to meet in person, while others participate virtually. The virtual option continues to be a popular, frequently used choice by both parents and LEAs, as it accommodates the parties’ unique needs.

Fiscal year (FY) 2019⁴ is when the pandemic and resulting shutdown occurred, and pandemic-related school closures continued into FY 2020. The statistics from those years are outliers, and difficult to reconcile within a five-year comparison of ODR services. What is clear, however, is that stakeholders are choosing mediation more frequently than in past years (excluding the FY 2019 and FY 2020 years), as well as Individualized Education Program (IEP) facilitation, a state level dispute resolution option. Due process complaints dropped from 1064 in FY 2021 to 900 during this reporting period. ODR continues to work with a research and evaluation consultant in analyzing the statistical data. ODR continues to provide an array of services for stakeholders to choose from, which best meet their individual needs.

ODR Stakeholder Council

The ODR Stakeholder Council brings together representatives from a broad array of stakeholders to provide functional input and recommendations on the special education dispute resolution system. Detailed

biographical information on each member is available on the ODR website.⁵ ODR, with its Stakeholder Council, remains committed to presenting the benefits of mediation as an effective dispute resolution tool, while continuing to recognize due process as an important procedural safeguard for parents.

Outreach

Presentations by ODR staff and hearing officers included: Pennsylvania Bar Institute (PBI); Special Education Advisory Panel (SEAP); and various Intermediate Units, School Districts, Local Task Force groups, and parent groups. Hearing officers have also been invited to speak about dispute resolution procedures and options in teacher preparation courses for special educators. Again this year, ODR, CADRE, and the State of Oklahoma planned and will co-sponsor a national Hearing Officer Academy to be held in 2026. As needed, ODR staff produce videos and materials relevant to both parents and educators. ODR staff participated

as exhibitors at multiple conferences throughout the reporting period. Exhibit tables were hosted at the following events: National Autism Conference, Community of Practice Transition Conference, Pennsylvania Bar Institute's Exceptional Children Conference, and the Pennsylvania Department of Education's Annual Conference.

Hearing Officer Training

Hearing officers engage in rigorous professional development each year, both in-house and through highly regarded professional associations. The seminal training for the hearing officers each year is Exceptional Children Conference (ECC), sponsored by the Pennsylvania Bar Institute and planned by a committee of practitioners in the field of special education law. Many times, ODR hearing officers are asked to present a session and/or facilitate sessions.

Each hearing officer must obtain 12 continuing


legal education credits a year to remain in good standing with the Supreme Court of Pennsylvania. Therefore, in addition to the hearing officers' attendance at the ECC conference, they attend trainings through other entities such as the LRP Media Group; the National Association of Hearing Officials (NAHO); Pennsylvania Department of Education; Council of Administrators of Special Education (CASE); Pennsylvania Association for Gifted Education (PAGE), as well as other Pennsylvania bar-sponsored conferences.

Hearing Officer Settlement Conferences

Hearing Officer Settlement Conferences (HOSC) have become a permanent part of the resolution landscape and have had a positive impact. Annual settlement rates for cases utilizing HOSCs have consistently been in the range of 79–82% since its inception. This is especially encouraging because the HOSC is not an effort toward global resolution but is utilized when parties are close to resolution and find that they have reached an impasse or a hurdle that they can't seem to clear themselves in their efforts to resolve the dispute. Given the established nature of the offering and the consistency of the results year-to-year, HOSC data is no longer separately tracked and reported.⁶

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CONSULTLINE

The Special Education ConsultLine is an information helpline for parents and advocates with questions or concerns about special education for school-age children. It is staffed by three specialists who provide information on special education, gifted education, and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973. The goal of ConsultLine is to empower parents with knowledge so they can make informed decisions about next steps for their child.

ConsultLine specialists also manage ODR's parent engagement services by providing technical assistance to parents preparing for IEP facilitation, mediation, and/or representing themselves in a due process hearing. They also conduct outreach to families who have requested follow-up after using an ODR service or who participated in a mediation that did not result in a resolution.

ConsultLine provides the following information:

- ✓ The processes for having a child evaluated, identified, and provided with special education, accommodations, and related services;
- ✓ Parents' rights and procedural safeguards, including information about applicable regulations;
- ✓ Dispute resolution options for addressing disagreements about a child's special education program;
- ✓ The process and procedures related to a caller's active case involving IEP facilitation, mediation, or a due process hearing;
- ✓ Information, assistance, and access to the state complaint process managed by the Pennsylvania Department of Education's Bureau of Special Education (BSE); and
- ✓ Resources, publications, websites, and referrals to disability-related organizations.



ConsultLine can be reached via phone, email, online contact form, or ODR’s Live Chat website feature⁷. Specialists respond to requests for information by directly calling a constituent. In an attempt to speak with everyone who has requested information, specialists call individuals three times over the course of three business days. This has been an effective protocol for providing service in an equitable and timely manner.

Live Chat allows constituents to ask questions in real time, Monday through Friday from 7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., about any ODR service. The LiveChat feature on the ODR website allows real-time messaging with a ConsultLine specialist. If a specialist is unavailable at the time of the chat, a ticket can be submitted through the LiveChat window, and a specialist will follow up with a return phone call.

ConsultLine specialists work diligently behind the scenes to ensure all constituents have access to up-to-date, accurate information and resources. Their work includes the following activities:

- ✓ Ensuring that hearing officer decisions are free of personally identifiable information and meet accessibility standards before being posted on ODR’s website;
- ✓ Maintaining the Hearing Officer Decisions and Parent Resource Library sections of ODR’s website;
- ✓ Conducting group presentations, both in-person and virtual, for interested stakeholders on the function, purpose, and services of ODR;
- ✓ Managing ODR’s publications to ensure they remain current and accessible; and
- ✓ Developing short informational videos on topics frequently discussed during ConsultLine calls.



Call Activity

During FY 2024, ConsultLine specialists served 2,939 constituents. Services included:

- ConsultLine calls, during which specialists answered questions and provided information to parents and advocates regarding special education concerns;
- Family engagement outreach, assisting parents who had an active facilitation, mediation, or due process hearing and were representing themselves;
- Outreach to parties involved in unresolved mediation sessions (those that did not result in a written agreement) to gather feedback;
- Follow-up calls to respondents from the dispute resolution survey to discuss comments, suggestions, or concerns about their recent ODR service; and
- ODR LiveChat support, where specialists responded to questions and provided information via the website's chat feature.

ConsultLine specialists support constituents who speak a language other than English through a third-party interpretation service. In FY 2024, this service was used 40 times to assist individuals in their preferred language. With the help of interpreters, ConsultLine assisted callers who spoke Arabic, Chinese, and Spanish.

Caller-Identified Regional Distribution of Inquiries

Callers are not required to provide regional information, but 1,055 callers voluntarily identified their location during FY 2024. The following reflects the distribution of those inquiries based on the locations provided.

Types of Inquiries

ConsultLine specialists document the primary topics related to each caller's question(s). In FY 2024, the most frequently recurring topics, listed in order of frequency, included the following:

Other high-interest topics included IEP implementation, eligibility, and the complaint process.

Specialists provided publications, forms, web resources, and other materials related to callers' concerns in 1,558 instances. The majority of this information was electronically delivered.

Call Resolution Process and Provision of BSE Complaint Packets

ConsultLine offers information to parents about how to address concerns or file complaints related to special education. ConsultLine's Call Resolution Process (CRP) is an effective dispute resolution tool for addressing compliance-related concerns under IDEA and certain issues related to Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973. During a CRP, the specialist serves as a conduit of information between the parent and the school. As with all calls, regardless of content, the specialist does not act as an advocate, decision-maker, mediator, or compliance advisor, nor do they attempt to steer parents toward one particular dispute resolution option over another.

The CRP format includes an email summarizing the parent's compliance-related concerns and the parent's proposed resolution. This email is drafted by the specialist in consultation with the parent to ensure it accurately reflects the parent's concerns. Once finalized, the parent provides verbal consent to send the message to the LEA administrator responsible for special education, the appropriate regional BSE division chief, and the regional BSE advisor. Once the email is sent, the specialist's involvement in the CRP has concluded, and BSE takes responsibility.

During FY 2024, a CRP was offered to 34 callers and, with the parent's permission, distributed in 26 instances. Common reasons for declining distribution included the parent's belief that the email would not be effective, a preference to file a formal complaint instead, or a desire to first attempt another IEP meeting.

Information about the BSE complaint process and the state complaint form is provided to parents when a CRP is offered, as well as upon specific request. In FY 2024, 266 state complaint

forms and accompanying information packets were distributed to callers.

Gifted Education

ConsultLine specialists assist callers with questions or concerns related to Chapter 16 of the Pennsylvania School Code and gifted education. In some cases, callers allege compliance violations. When this occurs, the specialist provides information about the procedural safeguards for gifted education, including the option to file a written complaint. In FY 2024, ConsultLine responded to 58 callers whose concerns were specifically related to gifted education. The most frequently discussed topics included questions about Chapter 16 regulations, procedural safeguards, Gifted Individualized Education Program (GIEP) content, and gifted multidisciplinary evaluations.

Professional Development

ConsultLine staff continue to engage in high-quality professional development to stay well-informed and effective in providing accurate information and relevant resources to callers. During FY 2024, staff participated in several professional learning opportunities, including The Weatherly Review: Quarterly Legal Update; CASE Collective: Leading in Light of Current Circumstances; CADRE Recapping Significant 2024 IDEA Legal Decisions; and the Pennsylvania Bar Institute's Exceptional Children Conference.

ConsultLine Feedback

When callers provide contact information, specialists conclude service by sending a brief, anonymous evaluation survey via mail or email. The survey includes space for comments and five satisfaction-based questions. Respondents are asked to assess the usefulness of the information provided, the identification of options for resolving concerns, the timeliness

of service, and overall satisfaction. In FY 2024, survey results indicated that ConsultLine continues to maintain a high level of satisfaction among constituents.



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FACILITATION

ODR offers facilitation services for IEP meetings, Individualized Family Service Plan (IFSP) meetings, GIEP meetings, Section 504 meetings, and Resolution Meetings. Facilitation is a state-sponsored dispute resolution option and is not mandated by federal or state law⁸. All facilitation services are voluntary and may only occur when all parties agree to include a neutral third party, a trained facilitator, to support the meeting process.

Resolution Meeting Facilitation

A resolution meeting is required when a parent files a due process complaint, unless both parties agree in writing to waive the meeting or choose to use mediation in lieu of the resolution meeting. If the parties believe that involving a neutral third party could support productive discussion and increase the likelihood of reaching an agreement, they may request a facilitator from ODR. Resolution Meeting Facilitation (RMF) helps parents and school personnel stay focused on the student's needs and work collaboratively toward a resolution, with the possibility existing that completion resolution of the dispute will obviate the need for a due process hearing.

During FY 2024, ODR received eight requests for Resolution Meeting Facilitation. Of the eight facilitated meetings held, two resulted in full resolution agreements and one resulted in a partial agreement. The remaining cases were either declined (2), did not result in an

agreement (2), or were withdrawn (1). None of the cases proceeded to a fully adjudicated due process hearing.

IEP Facilitation

IEP Facilitation is a voluntary process offered when both parents and school staff agree that a neutral third party could support the IEP meeting. The facilitator helps foster open, respectful communication and guides the team in working collaboratively to develop an appropriate and effective IEP for the student.

Facilitation services are also available for IFSP meetings for birth-3, IEP meetings for preschool students, GIEP meetings for students who are gifted, and meetings for students eligible under Section 504.

Requests


In FY 2024, ODR received 139 requests for IEP, IFSP, GIEP, or Section 504 facilitation. This is similar to the number of requests received in the previous fiscal year (144). Two of these requests were initiated in the prior fiscal year but closed during FY 2024. As in past years, the vast majority of requests (130) were for IEP meetings for school-aged students. Of the remaining nine requests, one was for an IFSP meeting for a child aged birth to 3, two were for IEP meetings for preschool children aged 3-5, and six were for GIEP meetings. No facilitations were requested for Section 504 meetings.

Outcomes

IDEA IEP Facilitation

Early Intervention Ages Birth-3

There was one request for IFSP facilitation for a child in the Birth-3 early intervention program. The meeting was held, and an IFSP was completed.

Early Intervention Ages 3-5

There were two requests for IEP facilitation for children ages 3-5. One request was withdrawn, and the other was declined.

School Age

In FY 2024, there were 130 requests for IEP facilitation for school-aged students. Two of these were initiated in FY 2023 but completed

in FY 2024. A total of 74 facilitated IEP meetings were held. Of those meetings, 44 resulted in a completed IEP, 14 resulted in a partially drafted IEP, and 16 did not result in a completed IEP, even with the support of a facilitator. These outcomes indicate that 78% of the facilitated IEP meetings held during FY 2024 led to either a full or partial IEP draft. Not all facilitation requests moved forward to a meeting. Forty-one requests did not progress for various reasons, and 13 were withdrawn. In 16 instances, one or both parties declined to participate in a facilitated IEP meeting. In seven cases, the LEA did not respond to the request, and in 17 cases, the parent did not respond. In one case, ODR was unable to locate a facilitator. At the close of the FY 2024 reporting period, two IEP facilitation cases remained active.

Gifted Education

There were six requests for GIEP facilitation during FY 2024. None of these requests moved forward to a facilitated meeting. In two instances, the parties declined to participate, and in four cases, the requests were withdrawn.




FIGURE 3: OUTCOMES OF IEP MEETINGS HELD WITH A FACILITATOR




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MEDIATION

Pennsylvania is a member of the 7-PAK Consortium of Large States,⁹ which encompasses the seven states with the largest number of children and students receiving special education services. While strict comparisons cannot be made among all states in the country, looking at states with similar characteristics to Pennsylvania provides some insight. When comparing Pennsylvania to the 7-PAK, the Commonwealth’s rate of dispute resolution activity is comparable, as is evident in the following three comparison charts¹⁰, which show the most recent federal data available (2022):

FIGURE 5: MEDIATIONS HELD PER 10K, FY 2020 THRU FY 2022





FIGURE 6: MEDIATION AGREEMENTS PER 10K, FY 2020 THRU FY 2022



Mediation Outreach and Training

During FY 2024, ODR continued its efforts to raise awareness about mediation and highlight the benefits of the service. No-cost information sessions about ODR services, including mediation, were offered to LEAs, universities, and parent organizations.

To ensure the delivery of high-quality mediation services, ODR's contracted mediators participated in professional development activities throughout the year focused on both special education law and effective mediation practices. In FY 2024, an ODR hearing officer presented on IDEA Part B and Section 504, and a division chief from the Bureau of Early Intervention Services & Family Support presented on Part C. Mediators received training on writing effective mediation agreements and participated in the CADRE


Legal Update 2024. They also attended the Pennsylvania Council of Mediators Conference and quarterly Community of Practice meetings with their peers..

Summary of Mediation Data

During FY 2024, there were 555 requests for mediation. Additionally, there were 68 requests initiated during FY 2023 but closed in FY 2024. This brings the total number of requests, including rollover cases initiated in the previous fiscal year (but closed during this fiscal year), to 623.

Of the 555 requests for mediation during FY 2024, 91% of mediation requests this fiscal year (504) involved school age students with disabilities. Eighteen of these requests were for students who were twice exceptional, meaning they were eligible for both special education

and gifted education. There were 28 requests for children aged 3-5 (5% of total requests) and no requests for a birth-3 aged child. Requests for students participating in only gifted education programs comprised 16 of all mediation requests (3%) and there were seven requests for Section 504/protected handicapped students (1%). This is consistent with the distribution of requests from the previous year when 88% of requests involved school age students and 6.5% of requests involved children aged 3-5.





FIGURE 9: TOTAL MEDIATION REQUEST OUTCOMES




FIGURE 11: PA MAP OF MEDIATION REQUESTS BY INTERMEDIATE UNIT FOR FY 2022




FIGURE 12: PA MAP OF MEDIATION REQUESTS BY INTERMEDIATE UNIT FOR FY 2023





FIGURE 13: PA MAP OF MEDIATION REQUESTS BY INTERMEDIATE UNIT FOR FY 2024

Mediation Outcomes

The following mediation outcomes include all FY 2024 mediation requests plus the outcomes of FY 2023 mediation requests that remained active at the end of last reporting year and closed in FY 2024, for a total of 623 requests on which to report.

Total Mediation Agreement Rate

There were 280 mediations held in FY 2024. Of these mediations, 192 resulted in a signed mediation agreement, which is a mediation

agreement rate of 69%.

Breakdown of Outcomes by Age and Category Birth-3

There were no mediation requests for a birth-3 dispute.

Ages 3-5

Of the mediations requested for age 3-5 IDEA disputes, 16 moved forward to a mediation session. Of these, 56% resulted in a signed mediation agreement.









Mediation is a voluntary process, and therefore, neither families nor LEAs are obligated to agree to participate, nor are they required to report the reason for their refusal to participate. This makes it challenging to assess why mediation is utilized in some instances and not others.

Mediations Held Without Agreement

When mediation is held but the parties are unable to reach a written agreement, ConsultLine staff follow up with participants to better understand why the mediation did not result in resolution and to provide information about other available dispute resolution options. The majority of respondents report that the parties were each entrenched in their respective positions and couldn't reach compromise. This feedback is also used to inform training and professional development for mediators.

In FY 2024, there were five mediations held that had a related due process complaint active at the same time as the mediation session. Three of those resulted in a signed mediation agreement, thereby eliminating the need for a due process hearing. Two did not come to an agreement and resulted in a fully adjudicated hearing with a hearing officer decision.

Parties frequently report to ODR that after their unsuccessful mediation session, the parties continue discussions and end up coming to an agreement outside of mediation. These responses support what mediators report and what the mediations related to due process data above supports, which is that even when parties are unable to reach agreement at the mediation session, settlement is still a possibility afterwards. While these forms of agreement may not have been documented in a mediation agreement, they demonstrate that while a mediation looks "unsuccessful" on paper, it has oftentimes moved the dispute forward toward resolution.

Evaluative Mediation

In addition to facilitative mediation, ODR offers evaluative mediation. In facilitative mediation, the mediator guides the parties toward common ground without offering opinions or



evaluations. The mediator does not assess the strength or weakness of either party's position but instead supports open communication and mutual understanding.

In evaluative mediation, the mediator still uses facilitative techniques but may also ask more directive questions and provide feedback or suggestions for the parties to consider. The mediator may help the parties explore possible outcomes and discuss how a hearing officer might view the issues.

In FY 2024, there were 107 requests for evaluative mediation—an increase of 970%. This rise is due to a change in ODR's request form, which now allows parties to indicate a preference for either facilitative or evaluative mediation at the start of the process. Like facilitative mediation, evaluative mediation is voluntary. If the parties do not agree to evaluative mediation, they may still proceed with facilitative mediation.

Of the 107 requests, 57 evaluative mediation sessions were held, and 72% of those resulted in a signed agreement. Sixteen sessions were held but did not come to an agreement. Of the remaining cases, five were declined, 14 were withdrawn, and 31 were still active at the end of the reporting period.

Virtual Mediation


ODR offers the option of both in-person and virtual mediation. Parties can choose whether they prefer the mediation session to take place virtually via Zoom or in-person. While virtual mediation was initially adopted out of necessity during school closures caused by the COVID-19 pandemic, it has remained a popular option, even after schools returned to in-person learning.

Of the mediations requested in FY 2024, 78% were conducted virtually. This figure does not include cases initiated in FY 2023 but closed in FY 2024. Virtual participation offers greater scheduling flexibility and can be more convenient for families who may otherwise face barriers to attending an in-person mediation.

Of the virtual mediations requested during FY 2024, 65% resulted in a signed agreement. In contrast, 80% of in-person mediations resulted in a signed agreement during the same time period. ODR has observed that parties sometimes allocate less time for virtual mediations conducted via Zoom. To address this, ODR encourages all parties to allow sufficient time for the full mediation process and has updated its scheduling procedures to ensure adequate time is allotted for each session.


FIGURE 18: MEDIATIONS HELD VIRTUALLY VS. IN-PERSON

Attorney Participation

Mediation in Pennsylvania underwent a significant change in March 2021 with the introduction of attorney participation under certain circumstances. Since the inception of Pennsylvania’s special education mediation program in 1986, attorneys had not been permitted to attend or participate in mediation in any capacity. In FY 2020, the Special Education Advisory Panel endorsed a change to this long-standing policy, recommending that the Commonwealth adopt the same approach to attorney participation used in resolution meetings. This decision was consistent with practices in virtually every other state.

As of March 1, 2021, if a family chooses to bring an attorney to mediation, the LEA may also bring legal counsel. If the family opts not to bring counsel, the LEA is not permitted to bring counsel. Notably, prior to this change, Pennsylvania was one of only four states that did not permit attorney participation in mediation.

As shown in Figure 19, 17% of the mediation requests submitted in FY 2024 involved parties who were represented by an attorney, while in 83% (460), parties remained unrepresented. This demonstrates that parents continue to utilize mediation in most instances without legal representation. However, for those who choose to bring an attorney, that option is now available. A key strength of this mediation model is that it offers parents flexibility and choice in how they participate.

Of the mediations requested in FY 2024, 24 included attorney participation, with 38% resulting in a signed agreement. This figure does not include cases initiated in FY 2023 but closed in FY 2024.

Of the mediations requested in FY 2024

that did not involve attorney participation, 70% resulted in a signed agreement. This pattern has remained consistent since attorney participation was introduced: higher agreement rates are observed when attorneys are not present. It is important to note, however, that this reflects only the agreement rates, not the quality or satisfaction associated with the agreements reached.






FIGURE 20: MEDIATION OUTCOMES AND ATTORNEY PARTICIPATION

Pre-Mediation Outreach and Mediation Outcomes

In March 2021, when attorneys were first permitted to participate in mediation, ODR implemented a requirement for pre-mediation outreach in cases involving represented parties. This addition was made to address concerns that attorney fees might pose a barrier to reaching a mediation agreement. Mediators were asked to discuss fee-related expectations with the attorneys in advance, with the goal of resolving the issue prior to the mediation session. For mediations involving unrepresented parties, pre-mediation outreach remains optional.

When pre-mediation outreach was completed and a mediation session was held, the agreement rate was 66% (which was 28%

higher than the overall agreement rate for represented parties). Among mediations involving only unrepresented parties, the agreement rate was 69% when pre-mediation outreach occurred, which is consistent with the overall agreement rate for non-represented parties.


DUE PROCESS

Parents or educational agencies may resolve educational disputes through a mechanism called due process. Due process differs from other dispute resolution opportunities in that a hearing officer decides the dispute for the parties. Throughout the due process proceedings, resolution through mediation and facilitation remains available to the parties, as does Hearing Officer Settlement Conferences. In addition, during the proceedings, the parties may settle some or all of the issues among themselves at any time, and in most instances, do so.

Due Process Requests

Beginning with the Annual Report for FY 2020, ODR began reporting data from CADRE¹², the national technical assistance center on special education dispute resolution, in order to deepen the understanding of dispute resolution across the country and Pennsylvania’s standing in the national picture. CADRE’s national data collection—which is current through FY 2022—demonstrates that


FIGURE 21: DUE PROCESS COMPLAINTS FILED PER 10K FOR 7-PAK STATES, FY 2020 THRU FY 2022

special education dispute resolution activity nationwide is not monolithic. There are vast differences between and among all states based on both child count and activity. Despite Pennsylvania’s size, the Commonwealth’s rate of due process is comparable to the nation’s average and is not an outlier.

Pro Se Parents

The majority of due process requests come from an attorney representing the parent. In a minority of cases, parents requested ODR services on their own, without being represented by counsel (i.e., “pro se”). FIGURE 23: DUE PROCESS REQUESTS - BIRTH-3




FIGURE 24: DUE PROCESS REQUESTS – 3-5




FIGURE 25: DUE PROCESS REQUESTS – SCHOOL AGE




FIGURE 26: DUE PROCESS REQUESTS – SECTION 504





FIGURE 27: DUE PROCESS REQUESTS – GIFTED EDUCATION





FIGURE 29: PA MAP OF DUE PROCESS REQUESTS BY INTERMEDIATE UNIT FY 2022





FIGURE 31: PA MAP OF DUE PROCESS REQUESTS BY INTERMEDIATE UNIT FY 2024

Appeals to the State and Federal Court

During FY 2024, there were 19 appeals to federal court and one appeal to state court. Only four of these appeals pertained to FY 2024 requests for hearing, with the balance pre-dating the reporting period. Parents accounted for 75% of the total number of appeals filed¹⁷. Three of the appeals were limited to attorneys fees. At the close of the reporting period, 17 cases were still in progress. The Court dismissed one case following a party settlement, dismissed another based on the final resolution of a separate matter, and approved a Settlement Agreement in a third instance. That case has since been settled by parties and the Court vacated the remand order.



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



Description: The raw counts of special education compliance complaints for the local educational agencies (LEAs) within each Intermediate Unit (IU) form the basis for the percentages shown in Figure X. These percentages illustrate the share of noncompliance issues by category compared to the statewide total.

During the 2024–2025 school year, the IU 12 region accounted for 4.71% of all findings of noncompliance, with 1.18% in Chapter 15/Section 504, 2.35% in IEP Implementation, and 1.18% in Least Restrictive Environment. The LEAs within IU 14 represented 3.53% of the total, spread evenly across IEP Development, IEP Implementation, and Least Restrictive Environment at 1.18% each. IU 15 LEAs also reflected 4.71% of the total, with findings in IEP Development, IEP Implementation, Prior Written Notice, and Timelines, each at 1.18%. The IU 16 region had a single area of noncompliance totaling 2.35%, all in IEP Implementation. LEAs within IU 2 contributed 2.35% of the total, with 1.18% in Chapter 15/Section 504 and 1.18% in IEP Development. The IU 20 region had 1.18% of the total, entirely within Chapter 15/Section 504. IU 21 LEAs accounted for 3.53%, divided across IEP Implementation, Prior Written Notice, and Timelines, each at 1.18%. IU 22 LEAs reflected 2.35%, all in IEP Implementation.

The IU 23 region represented 9.41% of findings, with 1.18% in Access to Records, 1.18% in IEP Development, 2.35% in IEP Implementation, 1.18% in Prior Written Notice, and 3.53% in

Timelines. LEAs within IU 25 accounted for 8.24%, with 2.35% in IEP Development, 3.53% in IEP Implementation, 1.18% in Prior Written Notice, and 1.18% in Related Services. The IU 26 region had the largest share, 32.94% of all findings, including 1.18% in Behavior Management, 2.35% in IEP Development, 12.94% in IEP Implementation, 3.53% in Prior Written Notice, 2.35% in Related Services, and 10.59% in Timelines. The LEAs within IU 27 accounted for 8.24% of noncompliance, with 1.18% in Discipline, 1.18% in IEP Development, 3.53% in IEP Implementation, 1.18% in Prior Written Notice, and 1.18% in Related Services. IU 3 LEAs represented 14.12% of the total, including 1.18% in Discipline, 3.53% in IEP Development, 3.53% in IEP Implementation, 1.18% in Least Restrictive Environment, 2.35% in Prior Written Notice, and 2.35% in Timelines. Finally, both IU 5 and IU 6 regions each accounted for 1.18% of findings, with all noncompliance in IEP Implementation.
